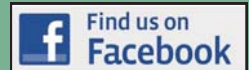

Rosary: Daily at 6:20 a.m.

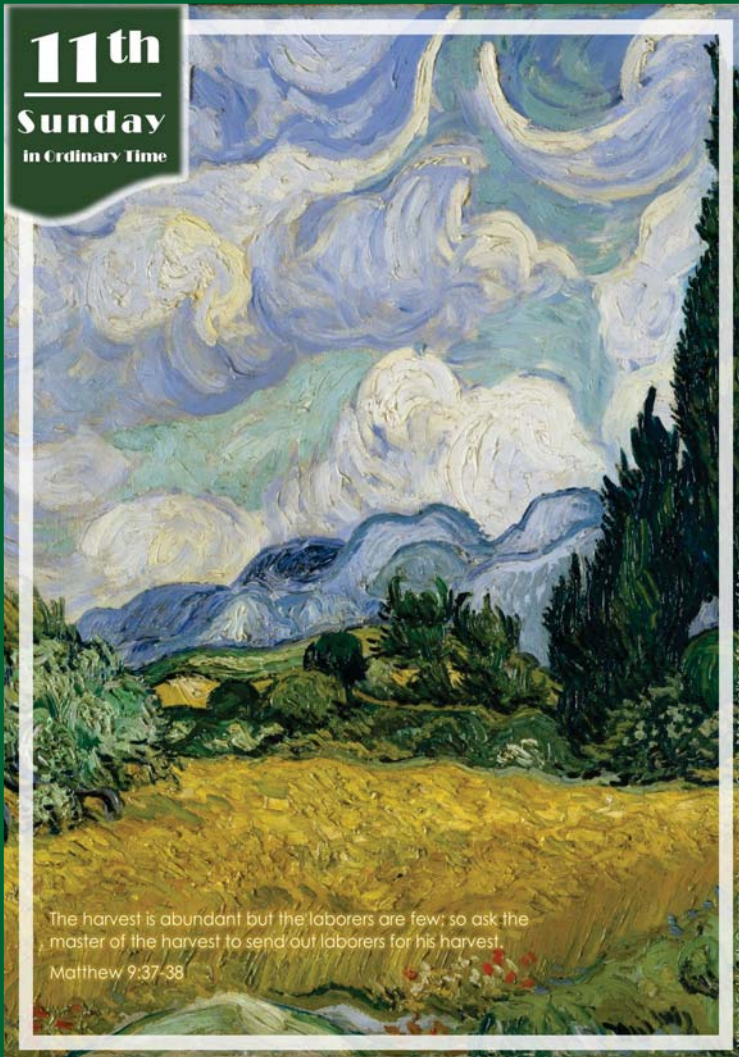

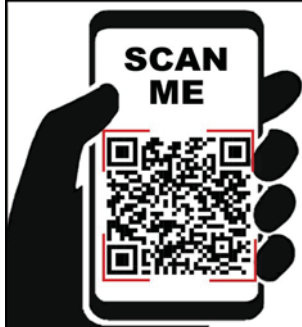
