



TOPICS: TRADITIONAL LATIN MASS RESOURCES










Leaflet Missal provides a compact source for praying the Tridentine Mass in Latin as well as other traditional prayers and meditations.







TOPIC: CONTEMPLATIVE PRAYER & MENTAL PRAYER





Spiritual masters have always taught that prayer is crucial in our relationship with God. But many of us feel unsure about how to go about it. What exactly is prayer? Who is it for? And




Taking concrete examples from our everyday life, the author invites us to respond in a Christ-like fashion to the upsetting situations we must all confront.

TOPIC: MORALITY






By addressing both what people think the Church says and what the Church actually says about contraception, Dr. Franks clears up common confusions and objections. She






matters of "gender identity"?






