**WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT...?****Gospel Comparisons Part I:**

**Writer** – Mark, a second generation Christian, possibly a follower of Peter; traditionally the John Mark of Acts

**Date Written** – 65-70 CE

**Images of Christ** – The suffering Servant of God, Son of Man, Son of God, Messiah, and Lord

**The Author's Community** – A Gentile Christian community in Rome undergoing persecution

**Theological Themes** - Jesus shows that the suffering in our lives can be a source of grace when united to the sufferings of Christ

**Historical Situation** – The Romans subdue armed Jewish rebellions. Christians experience persecution in Rome

**Caesars** - Nero (54-68 CE)

**Writer** – Matthew, An unknown Jewish Christian, traditionally the Apostle Matthew

**Date Written** – 75-80 CE

**Images of Christ** – Teacher and prophet like Moses, Son of God, Son of Man, Messiah, and Lord

**The Author's Community** – A Jewish Christian community in Antioch, Syria

**Theological Themes** – Jesus teaches what it means to be a member of the Kingdom of heaven. He prepares his followers to continue his teachings and ministry.

**Historical Situation** – Written after Romans had destroyed all of Jerusalem, including the Temple of Herod

**Caesars** – Vespasian and Titus (70-81 CE)

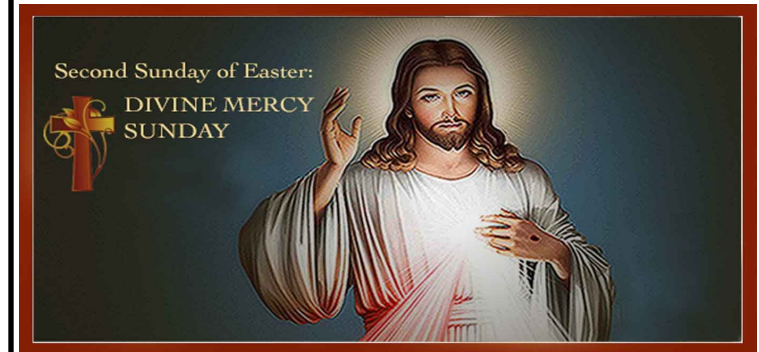
