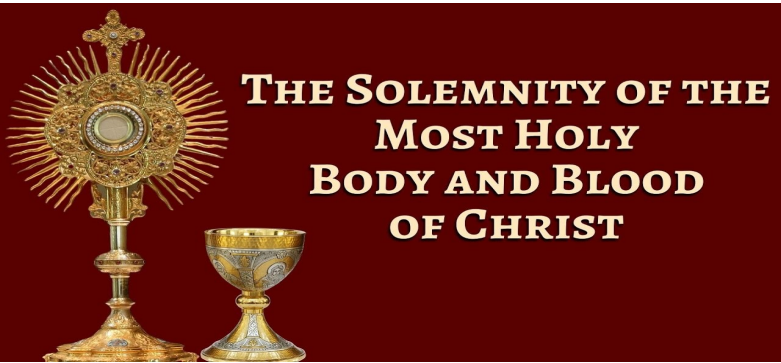

WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT. . . ?

The Book of Numbers:

Sound the trumpet, beat the drum, we are going to war! The call to arms brings out the best and the worst in people—courage and cow-ardice, love and hate, hope and fear. The Book of Numbers records the varied experiences of the Israelites as they prepare for the armed con-quest of the Promised Land . But most important, it tells of God’s insist-ence that they maintain their purity and holiness to be worthy recipients of God’s promise.

The Book of Joshua:

When you were young, did you ask to hear your favorite story over and over again? Often familiar stories appeal to us because of their simple justice—good triumphs over evil. There is something reassuring in knowing that in the end, good wins out and evil is punished, no matter how many times we hear it. That is the basic message of the Book of Joshua. In the conquest of the Promised Land, the author reminds us that those who follow God are rewarded, and those who do not are punished, pure and simple.
