



DAY 1: FLIGHT TO ROME

Today, you will board your international flight to Rome! Rest assured, all necessary preparations have been made. Just sit back, relax, enjoy the flight, and focus on the spiritual journey ahead.

DAY 2: ROME • TREVI FOUNTAIN

Upon arrival at Leonardo da Vinci-Fiumicino Airport, you will meet your Nativity Pilgrimage tour guide and board your deluxe touring vehicle. As we exit the airport, we will begin a panoramic tour to get acquainted with "The Eternal City." We will stop by the famous Trevi Fountain, where there will be free time for lunch. After lunch, we will proceed to our hotel for the evening. Dinner and overnight accommodations in Rome.

DAY 3: ROME • VATICAN • ST. PETER'S BASILICA • VATICAN MUSEUM • ST. MARY MAJOR

After breakfast, we will leave the hotel early for the papal audience with Pope Francis in St. Peter's Square! After the audience, we will explore the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica, the largest church in Christendom Church, St. Peter's Basilica. Inside, you will be in awe of this incredible cathedral, housing some of the church's most precious artwork, like Michelangelo's Pieta. Next, we will continue to the Vatican Museums, filled with art galleries and awe-inspiring relics. Additionally, you will observe the Tapestry Gallery, the Raphael

Rooms, and the world-famous Sistine Chapel, where the Pope is elected. Our final stop in the Vatican will be the tomb of Saint John Paul II. Afterward, we will continue to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, which contains a relic from the Manger of the Infant Jesus! We will return to our hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations in Rome.

DAY 4: ROME: ST. JOHN LATERAN • HOLY STAIRS • ST. PAUL OUTSIDE THE WALLS • CATACOMBS

This morning, you will enjoy an early breakfast before exploring the Basilica of St. John Lateran, Rome's oldest major basilica, where Pope Francis was installed as Bishop of Rome. Next, you will cross the street to visit the Holy Stairs, the same steps that led to Pontius Pilate's praetorian in Jerusalem, where Jesus walked during his Passion. Saint Helena brought the stairs to Rome in the fourth century. We will continue our journey down the Appian Way, the earliest road of Ancient Rome, where we will visit the Domus Quo Vadis Chapel, the Baths of Caracalla, the Arch of Drusus, the Tomb of Cecilia Metella, and the catacombs of St. Callixtus. Our day concludes with a visit to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, originally founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th Century. It is the burial place of St. Paul the Apostle. We will then return to your hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations in Rome.
