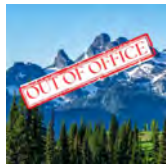
### **OUR PARISH VISION**

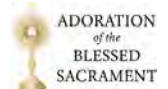

### Your Faith Has Made You Well



#### Reflect

Jesus applauded a woman with a flow of blood with the words, "Your faith has made you well." In turning God, she discovered new energies that changed the

course of her illness. Physicians and medical scientists speak about the "faith factor" in health or illness. When we trust God, our inner resources are enlivened and change our lives. Authentic faith can be a tipping point in the well-being of our cells and souls.

#### Pray

Healing God,  
Help me to trust your love in troubled times.  
I do not ask for a supernatural rescue operation.  
I ask for the courage to trust and have faith in  
Your loving power, already present in my cells and soul.  
Help me to reach out to you  
And claim your energy of love  
That will change my life and change the world.  
Amen.

#### Act

God is always here to help us. Recognizing that we can't do it alone, help me to trust God's power of love in my life. In my imagination, like the woman with the flow of blood, let me reach out to Jesus, and do all that is my power, in response, to promote my well-being and the well-being of those around me.



### 20<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

In our family, there is a long history of kids asking questions that adults simply cannot answer. The questions usually begin with the word 'why' or 'how' and delve into the imponderables of life: questions about the invisible, the unknown, the uncertain or the unusual. The worst questions are those for which there should be an answer, but none exists, at least at that moment. So, here is an imponderable question: How do you explain the unexplainable?

Jesus comes not with a question, but a teaching that causes some confusion and uncertainty. They ask the imponderable question: how can this be? How can He give us His flesh to eat? Jesus does not explain directly. He tells them who He is, where He comes from, and what they must do. His disciples have also expressed their doubts and bewilderment. Jesus simply reminds them of His words and deeds and asks them to have faith and believe in Him.

We can answer this question, not so much in our minds as in our hearts. When we receive the Lord in the Eucharist, are we not drawn to Him? Do we not experience His Presence? Have we not seen what the Lord can do as we live our faith and offer our love? There will always be the skeptics and doubters, and some of that may creep into our minds. Ask the Lord those questions and He will answer you. You will taste and see the goodness of the Lord.
