The program we used is simple to use, however we need more small group leaders to help the program run smoothly. Small group leaders are given discussion questions, activities, and supplies for roughly 15-20 minutes of small group time for each session. Each session begins with an engaging game or activity followed by a 10 minute teaching. Small group leaders can give the large group lesson if they are comfortable, but this is not something that is expected. Refugee and Immigrant Resettlement

"Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me." Matthew 25:40

Steve leads the Southeast Massachusetts People Open to Welcoming Immigrants and Refugees (POWIR) Team. The team is a group of approximately 50 community volunteers who assist refugees and immigrants in adjusting to life in the U.S. Though affiliated with Catholic Charities, the team has members from various Christian congregations, the Jewish community, and many non-faith people of goodwill. It currently assists 45 immigrants and refugees from Asia, Europe, Africa, Central America, and South America residing in Plymouth, Sandwich, Cotuit, Hyannis, Hyannis, South Yarmouth, and New Bedford during all phases of their resettlement journey from arrival through independent living.

Steve will share his story from discernment through today in assisting immigrants and refugees during their resettlement journey with an emphasis on the spiritual aspects of his experiences.
