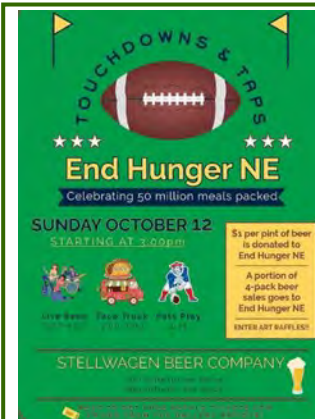


CALLING ALL KNITTERS!

St. Peter's Church has a significant history in town and an important anniversary. The cornerstone of the church was laid on July 4, 1873. Plymouth.

St. Peter's remained a mission of Abington / St. Bridget's until August 12, 1876 when it became an independent parish. So we are entering our 150th Anniversary and the church itself was completed in 1879. Since we are celebrating 150 years of being a Catholic presence in the town of Plymouth, the parade committee gave us permission to build our own float and be a part of this year's Thanksgiving Day Parade. 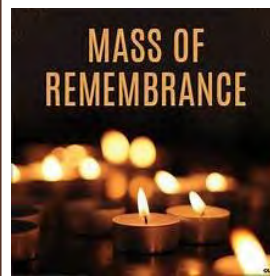


