


Adoration Opportunities





Reflection Question of the Week ~ 2nd Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday)



The scene in today's gospel takes place in a room where the apostles are locked in fear, unclear about what has just happened to Jesus and worried about their lives and future. Upon entering the room, Jesus allays their fears and commissions the disciples, and us, with these words: "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." The responsibility is clear, we are to go forth from our places of fear with the confidence that are not alone and to invite people into relationship with Jesus. Remember the words we heard last

week, "we are witnesses . . . commissioned to preach." We are being sent to be his instruments of mercy and peace.

- In what ways can I experience and share the peace of Christ?
- How do I respond to moments of doubt in my faith?
- How does being part of a faith community support my spiritual growth?




