# 4th Sunday of Easter

"My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish." (Jn 10:27-28)

Dear Parishioners,

Today's First Reading comes from Acts 13—just last week, we were in Chapter 5! That big leap reminds us how important it is to stay connected with Scripture every day. As Fr. Larry Richards says, "No Bible, no breakfast. No Bible, no bed." I often repeat that, because it's so true.

Much happens in the early Church as the Gospel begins to spread. Today, we see Paul and Barnabas preaching in the synagogue at Antioch. Though we skip most of Paul's sermon, it's worth reading in full to grasp the moment. What we do hear tells us that many people were moved by their message. So many, in fact, that the next Sabbath the synagogue was overflowing!

While some were joyful to hear the Good News—that Jesus Christ is Lord and has saved us through His death and resurrection—others reacted with jealousy and opposition. Acts tells us: "When the Jews saw the crowds, they were filled with jealousy and with violent abuse contradicted what Paul said."

It's important to understand that "the Jews" here refers specifically to certain leaders of the time—not all Jewish people. We should always be careful to avoid any interpretation that could lead to anti-Semitism. After all, Jesus, Mary, Joseph, Peter, Paul, and so many others in our faith story were themselves Jewish. Our faith calls us to love—not to judge or divide.

Religion should never be a source of hatred or exclusion. Jesus prayed that we might all be one, as He and the Father are one. Wherever there is division, there is sin. It is not by seeking Christ that we become divided—it is by ignoring Him.

Today is Good Shepherd Sunday, and our Gospel reading comes from John 10. Each year on this Sunday, we hear about Jesus as the Good Shepherd. In this year's short reading (Year C), Jesus speaks of two

relationships: one with His followers, and one with the Father. He promises us eternal life and assures us that no one can take us from His hand. He says:

"My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life... No one can take them out of my hand."

The unity Jesus shares with the Father is the unity He invites us into. When we are tempted by division—be it in thought, word, or action—we must ask whether we are truly following the voice of the Good Shepherd. Let us continue to listen for His voice, walk in His path, and live as people united in faith and love.



### Healing Mass in Honor of St. Peregrine


Patron Saint of Cancer Patients


