

Dear Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, Jesus gives us a command that lies at the heart of our Christian identity:

"I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

We've heard this many times, but the familiarity should not dull its power. Jesus is not offering a suggestion; He is giving us a commandment. This love—modeled on His own—is meant to be the unmistakable sign that we belong to Him.

And yet, this is perhaps the most difficult thing Jesus asks of us. Loving as He loves means offering mercy when it is not deserved, showing kindness when it is inconvenient, and persevering in love even when we are wounded by others. Critics outside—and even inside—the Church sometimes dismiss this call as weak or watered down. But the truth is, it is anything but. To love in this way is the hardest, most courageous thing a disciple can do.

The first reading from the Acts of the Apostles gives us a powerful example. Paul and Barnabas, on their missionary journey, have just preached in Derbe and are returning to Lystra, Iconium, and Antioch—cities that lie in modern-day Turkey. These places were not

always welcoming. In Lystra, Paul had recently healed a crippled man, only to be met with hostility. He was dragged out of the city, stoned, and left for dead.

Astonishingly, Paul did not give up. He got up, traveled to Derbe to continue preaching, and then returned to Lystra—the very city where he had nearly been killed. Why would anyone go back to a place of such danger and rejection?

Because Paul had been transformed by Christ's love. He was no longer living for himself. He was living for the mission of Jesus. And Jesus had made it clear: "As I have loved you, so you also should love one another."


Paul could say with conviction: "It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the Kingdom of God." These words were not about earning heaven through suffering. Rather, Paul was testifying that the Kingdom becomes visible on earth when we build a communion of love—when we create a community that reflects God's mercy, truth, and justice.

This is our call, too. We are not asked to be soft or sentimental. We are asked to be strong in the kind of love that picks itself up after being knocked down, that returns to hard places, that makes visible in the world the Kingdom Jesus died to establish.

This is not the work of wimps. This is the mission of saints.

Let us pray for the courage to love one another as He has loved us. Only then will the world know that we are truly His disciples.






#### **Crowning of the Blessed Mother**

The month of May is traditionally dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. One of the well-known ways of honoring Mary is with a May Crowning. In addition to the May Crowning there are other ways to honor our mother, Mary, throughout the month of May. One way is by praying the rosary each day. Another old tradition is planting a Mary garden. Mary gardens go back to the Middle Ages when certain flowers and herbs began to be symbolically associated with Mary.

The reason why we crown Mary is best summed up by Pope Paul VI who wrote in 1965 that May is an occasion for a "moving tribute of faith and love which Catholics in every part of the world pray to the Queen of Heaven." Last Sunday at the 9:30am Mass at St. Theresa and the 11:00am Mass at St. Andrew, a crown of flowers was placed on the head of a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary to signify her honor as Queen of heaven and earth. The children who participated also




