
## Sixth Sunday of Easter

"Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him." (Jn 14: 23)



St. Matthew the Evangelist Parish May 25, 2025 Dear Parishioners,

This weekend's first reading from the Acts of the Apostles recounts a pivotal moment in the life of the early Church: what many consider the first Church Council—the Council of Jerusalem. It was here that the Church began to define its universal mission more clearly, discerning how Gentile converts were to be welcomed into the community of faith.

Fr. William Kurz, SJ, of Marquette University, offers a beautifully concise summary of this council's importance in his commentary on Acts, part of the Catholic Commentary on Sacred Scripture series:

"The Council of Jerusalem is unquestionably a climactic moment in the history of the Church, for in it the Church's message is decisively extended to all nations. The council reaches conclusions on two related concerns: first, how Gentiles can be saved by Christ; second, how they are to relate to their Jewish-Christian brothers and sisters. The meeting provides today's Church with a helpful model for resolving controversies and discerning God's will as new questions arise... Salvation is by faith in Jesus rather than through the law... James... confirms [Peter's] teaching with the authority of Scripture... and decrees a pastoral application: Gentiles should not be required to be circumcised, but should follow certain practices to maintain unity in the community." (Kurz, Acts of the Apostles, pp. 232–233)

This moment in Church history reminds us that we are never left alone to figure out how to build the Church or share the Gospel. The Apostles believed, as we do, that their decisions were guided by the Holy Spirit. We continue to trust that the Holy Spirit directs the Church through her bishops and, in a particular way, through the ecumenical councils of the Church—twenty-one in number, from Nicaea I in 325 to Vatican II in the 1960s.

Though the Council of Jerusalem predates the formal structure of the Papacy and is not officially counted among the ecumenical councils, its inspired conclusions were embraced with authority by the whole Church. It reveals a model for discernment: listening, dialogue, witness, Scripture, and the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

This same Holy Spirit is promised in this Sunday's Gospel from John 14, where Jesus tells His disciples:


"I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, to be with you forever. This is the Spirit of truth... You know him, because he abides with you, and he will be in you."

We live in what the Church calls the Age of the Holy Spirit. Through the gifts we received in Baptism and Confirmation, we share in the ongoing mission of Christ. The Spirit empowers us to bear witness to Jesus—the Way, the Truth, and the Life—in a world searching for meaning and light.

Let us ask the Holy Spirit to renew in us the courage and clarity of the Apostles, so that through our lives, the Light of Christ may shine ever more brightly in our parish and our community. Come, Holy Spirit!

#### Reflection Question of the Week ~ 6th Sunday of Easter

Today, we are clearly reminded to keep Christ's commandment and follow his word rather than succumb to any popular narratives of the day. Listen to Jesus words again, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you." Following the example of Jesus, not the example of the world is how are lead to life eternal.

- Take a moment to reflect on the presence of God in our lives. We can feel His presence in our hearts and in the world around us.
- What does it mean to you that God's presence is everywhere?
- What steps can you take to feel more connected to God's presence?


