

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the 7th Sunday of Easter, while many other parts of the country are celebrating the Ascension. Boston, along with the Dioceses of Hartford, New York, Newark, Philadelphia, and Omaha, Nebraska continue celebrating Ascension Thursday on the original 40th day after Easter, which is always a Thursday. The rest of the country moved the Feast of the Ascension to the following Sunday. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops requested permission from the Vatican in 1999 for the change, and permitted Dioceses to make their own decision about celebrating the Feast on Thursday or Sunday. Our celebrating the Ascension on Thursday is not just proper to the Archdiocese of Boston, but in the Province of Boston, which includes what the Church calls the suffragan Dioceses in the province of Boston, which includes the Dioceses in Massachusetts, Boston, Fall River, Worcester, and Springfield, the Diocese of Burlington in Vermont, the Diocese of Manchester in New Hampshire, and the Diocese of Portland in Maine. So basically, the whole Northeast of the United States and the Archdiocese of Omaha in Nebraska celebrated the Ascension on Thursday.

One of the benefits of celebrating the 7th Sunday of Easter is that we get to hear the final part of Last Supper Discourses of Jesus... the "dinnertime con-


versation" He has with His Apostles after Judas leaves to betray Him, and before He goes out to pray and suffer His Agony in the Garden. These are beautiful and rich Scriptures... and today we read from Chapter 17. This Chapter concludes the Last Supper Discourses and if you have a "Red-Letter Bible", an edition of the Bible where all the words of Jesus are printed in red, you would see that this entire Chapter is spoken by Jesus. It is known as the "Priestly Prayer of Jesus". The Navarre Commentary writes "It is given that name because Jesus addresses his Father in a very moving dialogue in which, as Priest, he offers him the imminent sacrifice of his passion and death. It shows us the essential elements of his redemptive mission and provides us with teaching and a model for our own prayer. "The Lord, the Only-begotten and co-eternal with the Father, could have prayed in silence, if necessary, but he desired to show himself to the Father in the attitude of a supplicant because he is our Teacher […] Accordingly this prayer for his disciples was useful not only to those who heard it, but to all who would read it".

It is significant to note what Jesus is praying for in this prayer He makes; again, quoting from the Navarre Commentary on John: "The Priestly Prayer consists of three parts: in the first (vv 1–5) Jesus asks for the glorification of his holy human nature and the acceptance, by the Father of his sacrifice on the cross. In the second part (vv. 6–19) he prays for his disciples, whom he is going to send out into the world to proclaim the redemption which he is now about to accomplish. And then (vv. 20–26) he prays for unity among all those who will believe in him over the course of the centuries, until they achieve full union with him in heaven." We read this section, vv. 20-26, in this weekend's Gospel.

Unity is one of the fruits of the faith. Love of God leads us to love for each other and love for each other brings unity. Differences on Holy Days of Obligation seem to speak to a Church divided, which is contrary to Jesus' desire. St. Augustine is credited with saying "In essentials, unity; in non-essentials, liberty; in all things, charity." Jesus is concerned with making us all one in Him, not all the same. He concludes His prayer with these words: "Righteous Father, the world...does not know you, but I know you, and they know that you sent me. I made known to them your name and I will make it known, that the love with which you loved me may be in them and I in them." And when He had said this, He went out into the night to go to the garden, where the events of His Sorrowful Passion would begin.


Reflection Question of the Week ~ 7th Sunday of Easter


