Jesus said to his disciples: "If you love me, you will keep my commandments.

And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always." John 14:15-16



Dear Parishioners,

When I was a child, our family had a friend who was a missionary priest in Japan. His name was Fr. Emmett, a Franciscan with a deep love for the Gospel. From time to time, he would write letters to my mother, and I still remember how he closed one of them—near the end of the Easter Season—with the words, "Have a fiery Pentecost!" That phrase has stayed with me ever since. Every year as Pentecost approaches, I think of those words—and the fire of the Holy Spirit.

I find myself longing for that fire. I thirst for the Spirit to ignite my faith. I believe this "fire of the Spirit" is the essential ingredient for living with authentic joy in the life of grace. And it's not really a secret—God has generously poured out the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, and Fear of the Lord. We receive these Gifts at Baptism, and they are strengthened in us at Confirmation. They remain within us through the indwelling of the Holy Spirit—that Divine Life in our soul given at Baptism.

When these Gifts are stirred into flame, they bear fruit. The Fruits of the Spirit, listed in Galatians 5:22, are Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness, and Self-Control. Some sources expand this list to include twelve fruits, adding Modesty, Continence, and Longanimity—a word

that means patient endurance, or long-suffering.

The Holy Spirit—sometimes called "the Forgotten God"—is often the most misunderstood Person of the Trinity. Perhaps that's because the Father and the Son are revealed to us in familiar, relational terms. We know what it means to be a father or a son. But the Spirit is revealed in more mysterious ways: as a Dove, a Flame, Water, or Wind. Each image reveals something essential—the Spirit's majesty, might, mystery, and movement.

St. Augustine once wrote, "If you think you have understood God, it is not God you have understood, but yourself." God is ineffable—beyond words—yet He reveals Himself because He desires to be known. Even in mystery, God draws near.

It is often through the Holy Spirit that we most deeply encounter God—and fall in love with Him. These encounters can be life-changing. I recall my own most profound experience of the Spirit. I had been attending daily Mass at Immaculate Conception in Newburyport. Each morning before Mass, I would pray to the Blessed Mother, asking her to help me know Jesus more intimately. I always felt close to Mary, but I had often sensed a distance between me and Jesus—especially in the Eucharist.

Then one morning, as I prayed before Mass, something happened. It felt as though Jesus reached out from the Tabernacle and touched my heart. I was filled with a deep assurance of His Real Presence. That moment was a Consolation of the Holy Spirit. Mary always and only leads us to Jesus!

In this great mystery of divine presence, God makes Himself known and felt—not because we deserve it, but because He loves us. It's hard to describe, really. It's like trying to explain what it felt like to fall in love for the first time. You might say, "My heart is fluttering... I'm distracted... I can't sleep... I'm nervous and happy at the same time." A doctor might order tests! But someone who's been in love would simply smile and say, "Enjoy the warmth while you have it."

Or perhaps they'd echo what Fr. Emmett said so many years ago: "Have a fiery Pentecost!" ~ Father Chris






### **Legion of Mary- Our Lady of Hope**
