St. Matthew the Evangelist Parish June 15, 2025

Dear Parishioners,

The Easter Season has now come to a close with our joyful celebration of Pentecost last weekend. If you attend daily Mass, you've seen the vestments return to green for Ordinary Time. But for our Sunday liturgies, we pause Ordinary Time for two great solemnities, both celebrated in white: today's Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, and next week's Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ—Corpus Christi.

Each year on Trinity Sunday, I'm reminded of a beautiful stainedglass window that once graced St. Laurence O'Toole Church in Lawrence, where I grew up. That window, which now hangs in St. Augustine's Chapel (part of Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish in Lawrence and Methuen, where I was previously assigned), depicts a memorable scene from the life of St. Augustine.

The image shows St. Augustine walking along the seashore, deep in thought, trying to understand and explain the mystery of the Holy Trinity. Along the way, he encounters a little boy running back and forth between the ocean and a small hole in the sand. The child is using a seashell to carry water from the sea and pour it into the hole. Curious, Augustine asks, "What are you doing, little one?" The child replies, "I'm putting the ocean into this hole." Augustine gently responds, "That's impossible—the ocean is too



vast for such a small hole." The child then says, "And yet it is easier for me to put the whole ocean into this hole than for you to fit the mystery of the Trinity into your little mind." And with that, the boy vanished.

This story, often depicted in Christian art—including a painting by Alessandro Botticelli titled The



Vision of St. Augustine—offers a profound lesson. We may never fully comprehend the Trinity, but we are invited to know the Trinity. To know God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—is the heart of the Christian life.

This weekend, preachers around the world will try to help the faithful come a little closer to the mystery of the Triune God. But if your goal is to understand God completely, even the best homilist will fall short. You might be better off finding a quiet place at the beach, digging a small hole, and trying

to fill it with the sea!

May the love of the Father, the grace of the Son, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you always.

Reflection Question of the Week ~ Holy Trinity Sunday



We proclaim the Most Holy Trinity as a mystery of our faith. It is central to our Christian faith and life. The doctrine of the Trinity includes the truth that there are three persons in One God - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. While we will never fully understand this mystery in our lifetime, the creed we profess at Mass is an invitation to an ever deeper understanding of who God is and desires to be for us. The Sign of the Cross and the doxology or "Glory be ..." are two prayers that are easy to say. Use those prayers this week, and as you do so, ask the Holy Spirit to increase your faith in the Trinity.

- Take a moment to reflect on the Glory Be prayer. This prayer recognizes the power and dignity of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- What does the unity of the Holy Trinity teach us about working together?
- When reciting the creed, take a moment to think about the words as you recite them. Reflect on what they mean to you.


