

SAINTS PETER AND PAUL APOSTLES



Dear Parishioners,

This weekend the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles. The vestments worn this weekend are red, because both of these Apostles were martyrs. To understand why we celebrate this on Sunday, or why St. Peter and St. Paul "bump" Sunday Mass this weekend is to understand something called "the ranking of liturgical days." It is one of those technical aspects of Church that matter a whole lot to liturgists and "Church Junkies", but matter little to most people. Still, I think it is interesting and provides us an opportunity to understand something about the Church.

The Church has clearly defined guidelines about how to celebrate the Mass, which surprises no one of course, but if you were to wade into "Liturgical Arts and Sciences" your head would be spinning with words like simples, doubles, first class doubles, second class doubles, commemorations, vigils, octaves, and the list goes on and on. A much simpler way to understand Liturgical Ranking is to use the five categories of Solemnity, Feast, Memorial, Seasonal Weekday, and Ferial Weekday. A Solemnity is the highest ranking feast day. It commemorates an event in the life of Jesus or Mary or celebrates a saint important for the Church as a whole or for the local community, (for example the Feast of St. Patrick is a Solemnity in the Archdiocese of Boston because he is our Patron Saint.) The Mass of a solemnity has proper readings, and the Gloria and Creed are recited. Outside of Advent, Lent and Eastertide, if a solemnity falls on a Sunday, it is celebrated in place of the Sunday. A Feast has the rank of secondary liturgical days including lesser events in the life of Jesus, Mary or an Apostle (theologically speaking) or for major saints. An example of a Feast Day of the Lord in this category would be Epiphany. A Memorial is the commemoration of a saint of lesser importance. Many memorials are optional or only observed in specific dioceses, regions or nations. Seasonal Weekdays are a weekday in

a "strong" liturgical season (Advent, Christmas Season, Lent, Easter Season) on which no solemnity, feast, or memorial is observed, and the day would typically have specific prayers. A Ferial Weekday is a weekday in ordinary time on which no solemnity, feast or memorial is observed.

The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul commemorates their martyrdom for the faith. It is what is known as a 'first-class feast' so it "bumps" Sunday. This day was a Holy Day of Obligation in the universal Church calendar, but each Bishop's Conference can suppress the obligation as they have in the United States. This is a Holy Day of Obligation for England, Scotland, and Whales. It is a national holiday in Malta!

All of this liturgical gobbledygook matters little to most Catholics. But if you were wondering why I'm wearing red vestments this weekend, it's not because we are doing Pentecost over! And now you know the rest of the story. The important thing about this day is not found in all the *what*, but rather in the *who*. Today's Solemnity celebrates the martyrdom of two of the greatest Saints in Christendom. The New Testament is filled with their stories, their writings, and their spirit. The Church is filled with their wisdom and inspiration. St. Peter is the rock upon whom the Christian Church is built. St. Paul is the "Apostle to the Gentiles" who dedicated his life after his conversion to spreading the Gospel he once tried to squash. Their humanity reminds us that all saints are sinners. Their discipleship inspires us to persevere in our faithfulness to God regardless of the struggles we face, the weaknesses we have, or the mistakes we make. Saints Peter and Paul guided the Church in its earliest days. You and I help to guide it now. Take courage! Be faithful like they were! Saints Peter and Paul pray for us!

Sisters of the Good News Presentation from Last Week

With many of our parishioners already away for the summer months, we wanted to include the presentation the Sisters of the Good News shared last weekend at all of the Masses, for those who may not have been with us. The Sisters spoke beautifully about their mission and ministry. Their message was both inspiring and a reminder of the universal call to discipleship.

Good Morning /Good Afternoon Everyone-

We are the Sisters of Good News. We came to Massachusetts from India last winter to serve at The O'Connell House. This is our first time in the United States! We first want to say a sincere thank you to Father Chris Casey, and really everyone in this parish, for giving us such a warm welcome! You've all been so generous with your time and gifts! We love our new convent, our new parish - our new home! We're looking forward to getting to know you all as we are here more often. Thank you also Fr. Casey for inviting us to speak to everyone here today about the work we are involved in...

As I mentioned, we came here to work at *The O'Connell House*—it's a new safe home in this area that serves women who have been trafficked and who may be pregnant and/or may have small children. (There are only three houses like it in the United States!) We also have a unique model called the "Sister Care Model"— We Sisters are Caregivers to the residents and provide 24/7 care ---we are the loving, nurturing presence in the house---like mothers, we provide the love these women so desperately need!

You may not think human trafficking effects you, but believe us it does -- it happens everywhere--- in our own home countries of India, in the United States, and yes, even right in your own neighbor-hoods! It crosses all races, religions and socio-economic status. It truly can happen to anyone, anywhere, at any time. There are currently 50 million people trafficked worldwide, the majority are women & girls, and boys are affected as well, with the average age of entry being 11 to 14! And social media is a major factor in the increase of numbers. Parents--you need to be educated about this to protect your children!

Trafficking is a very lucrative business with profits reaching over \$260 Billion dollars each year – you may wonder how that could be? It is because you can sell drugs or weapons only once, but persons can be sold over & over again.

The women come to us from all over –they are identified by hospitals, local Police, FBI, Homeland Security and other shelters – and they need a bed placement. Currently, there is a *severe* shortage of beds for trafficking victims because they need very specialized care for complex trauma (they won't receive the help they need by going to just any shelter, as good as it may be.) The O'Connell House provides a solution, where women and their children are not only offered a bed, clothes and food, but also hope & healing in a safe, secure environment. They come with nothing, and they can stay up to 2 years, a typical stay averages 18 months. We work together with the healthcare and community social services to get all the necessary therapies and services they need—we provide for all physical, emotional and spiritual needs. Ultimately helping them to

transition to the next phase, and achieving their goal of independent living. The O'Connell House helps them go from being a victim, to being a survivor---while restoring their dignity.

Let me share some positive news--- We are very happy to tell you that our first baby born from The O'Connell House just celebrated her first Birthday this past April!! Her Mom named her "Susie" -- after the social worker at the hospital recognized the signs of trafficking and reported it -- Mom credits the social worker for saving her life.

We've had a few "firsts"....We also recently watched our first 'graduate' from our program to a more independent program ---which was so rewarding! This work is difficult, but we experience great joy from watching the women grow, heal and transform into the beautiful person God made them to be.

As you leave Church today, please make sure you take a brochure about The O'Connell House. You never know when you might need to reach out to us for help, or give it to someone who does! It has information about our services, along with our website, and ways to support us.

We are so very grateful for any donation you may be able to offer. Some people have asked about checks---you can simply make checks out to *The O'Connell House* and put them in the collection basket or mail them to the Parish Office ---again, we appreciate any thing you can give---we thank you in advance.

If you're unable to give at this time, we completely understand, we simply ask you to please keep us, and our residents and their children, in your prayers. We will do the same for you.

It's been a pleasure sharing about our work with you today. Thank you again for your warm welcome to us!!


