



THE PARABLE OF THE GOOD SAMARITAN

Which of these three, in your opinion, was neighbor to the robbers' victim?" He answered, "The one who treated him with mercy." Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise." Luke 10:36-37



Dear Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the Good Samaritan—a story that would have shocked His original audience. For centuries, deep animosity had existed between Jews and Samaritans, dating back to the Assyrian invasion in 722 BC. The Samaritans, who developed their own form of worship centered on Mount Gerizim, were seen by Jews as heretical. Relations between the two groups were marked by suspicion and hostility. So when Jesus makes a Samaritan the hero of His story—depicting him as the one who shows compassion and mercy—it would have been nothing short of scandalous.

Jesus tells this parable in response to a scholar of the law who asks what he must do to inherit eternal life. Rather than answer directly, Jesus turns the question back to him: "What is written in the law?" The man replies with the familiar words of the Shema and Leviticus: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself." Jesus affirms his answer: "You have answered correctly; do this and you will live." But then comes the deeper question: "And who is my neighbor?"

Through the story of the Samaritan, Jesus reveals that our neighbor is not just the one who lives nearby or shares our background, beliefs, or values. Our neighbor is anyone in need—anyone whom God places in our path. The Samaritan becomes a figure of Christ Himself: he sees, stops, helps, and loves without expecting anything in return. His mercy goes beyond all cultural, religious, and personal boundaries.

And in that, Jesus offers us a profound insight: we too are capable of loving as God loves. The Samaritan shows us what that love looks like—generous, sacrificial, freely given. The injured man does nothing to earn such love, and yet it is poured out upon him. That is how God loves us. Not because we are deserving, but because He is merciful.

When we choose to love generously, setting aside our own fears, prejudices, and self-interest, we mirror God's love to others. We become true disciples of Jesus, building up the Kingdom not with grand gestures, but with simple acts of mercy and compassion—seeing every person as a beloved child of God.

May we always be ready to stop for the one in need. May we love our neighbor not in word alone, but in action—and in doing so, may we make God's love known in our world. In Christ,


We are pleased to present to you a report on revenue and expenses. This includes offertory (received weekly at Masses, by mail, and online giving), as well as other revenue received throughout the month.

Reflection Question of the Week ~ 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Something that connects LOVE is CARING of each other

"... heed the voice of the LORD, your God, and keep his commandments and statutes ...," Moses reminds us that the commandments are readily accessible. The command, simply put is - Love God, love your neighbor. That commandment is made abundantly clear to us in the parable of the Good Samaritan that Jesus presents in today's gospel. Who is "my neighbor" that needs assistance today? We don't have to look very hard to see who that might be. As we heard in the first reading, we have the ability, it is "already in your mouths and in your hearts; you have only to carry it out." Jesus not only challenges us to be responsive, he also promises to give us the grace we need to carry out his command.

- The parable of the Good Samaritan challenges us to act with compassion, even when it is not easy.
- Who are the "neighbors" you find it hardest to love?
- How can Jesus help you let go of excuses and choose kindness?
- What small step can you take to be a better neighbor to those around you?


