
St. Matthew the Evangelist Parish July 20, 2025

 6^{th} Sunday in Ordinary Time



"Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things.

There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part

and it will not be taken from her." Luke 10:41-42



Dear Parishioners,

The dictionary defines *hospitality* as "the friendly and generous reception and entertainment of guests, visitors, or strangers." Most of us practice hospitality when we welcome people into our homes. In the ancient world, however—especially in the time of Jesus—hospitality was more than a social nicety. It was a moral obligation, and in harsh desert conditions, often a matter of life or death.

The Encyclopaedia Judaica notes:

"In ancient Israel, hospitality was not merely a question of good manners, but a moral institution which grew out of the harsh desert and nomadic existence led by the people of Israel. The biblical customs of welcoming the weary traveler and of receiving the stranger in one's midst was the matrix out of which hospitality and all its

tributary aspects developed into a highly esteemed virtue in Jewish tradition. Biblical law specifically sanctified hospitality toward the *ger* ('stranger') who was to be made particularly welcome: 'For you were strangers in a strange land'" (cf. Leviticus 19:34; Exodus 12:49).

This Sunday's readings highlight the spiritual dimension of hospitality. In Genesis, Abraham is visited by three mysterious guests. His eagerness to serve them—offering water, ordering food, and personally seeing to their comfort—is striking. The Church Fathers often saw in this scene a fore-shadowing of the Holy Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit visiting Abraham. It is also a sign of Abraham's unique relationship with God. Through the Covenant, he becomes not just a servant, but a friend—one with whom God speaks face to face.

In Jewish tradition, the two companions of the Lord in this passage are understood to be angels. After their visit, the three go on to Sodom, where the city's grave sin—among them a shocking failure of hospitality—leads to its destruction.

The Gospel offers a contrasting example. While Abraham runs to meet his guests with joy, Martha becomes flustered and frustrated. She welcomes Jesus into her home, but quickly becomes overwhelmed and resentful—focused more on the tasks of service than on the presence of her Guest. I always sympathize with Martha—I, too, often find myself in the kitchen at family gatherings. But Jesus gently redirects her attention:

"Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part, and it will not be taken from her."

This moment challenges all of us. We are called to place our love for God above all else—not by neglecting others, but by allowing our love for God to shape and perfect the way we love one another. True Christian hospitality begins in the heart, with attentiveness to the presence of Christ in each person we encounter.

Hebrews 13:1–2 reminds us:

"Let mutual love continue. Do not neglect hospitality, for through it some have unknowingly entertained angels."

And St. Paul, in his famous "Ode to Love," writes:

"So, faith, hope, love remain, these three; but the greatest of these is love" (1 Cor. 13:13).

May we grow in this greatest of virtues, and may our homes—and our parish—be places where Christ is always welcomed, and where strangers become friends. In Christ,

To help protect our community, our parish has removed email addresses from our website and bulletin, following the best practices recommended by the Archdiocese.

Once a single account is successfully hacked, it can be used to further compromise computer networks, applica-

tions, and even personal accounts. To help prevent this, the **St. Matthew** website now replaces email addresses with "**CLICK HERE**" links that take you to a secure contact form.

On **billericacatholic.org**, please go to the **ABOUT** tab at the top right, then select **CONTACT US** under **OUR PARISH**. You will find a **Contact Us** box that you can complete. Your message will be forwarded to the appropriate person or ministry. We ask that you include the name of the person or ministry you wish to reach in the comment box to help us direct your message promptly.

Important: If you ever receive an email from Father Chris or any other staff member asking for "help" or anything unusual, **please call the parish office first** to verify before responding.

Reflection Question of the Week ~ 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time



Last week's readings encouraged us to consider our response to the neighbor. Today we invited to consider the ways of extending hospitality. In the first reading, Abraham enthusiastically welcomes and provides for three strangers who come to him. In addition to warmly greeting them, he provided them water to bathe their feet and had Sarah, his wife, prepare a meal for them. In the gospel, Jesus stops on his way to Jerusalem to visit Martha and Mary. Martha is intent on preparing a meal for Jesus while Mary chooses to sit quietly in Jesus' company. Hospitality takes many forms,

whether at home or in our parish. Often it requires that we step out of our comfort zone to make room for a stranger, or someone we know very well. Pay attention today - God may put a stranger in your path who offers you hospitality or someone may be right in front of you who needs hospitality from you. How will you respond?

- Reflect on the importance of being hospitable ~ offering our best to others. By doing this, we show respect, kindness, and a welcoming spirit.
- How can you show hospitality in your daily life?
- How do you handle frustrations when things don't go as planned?
- How can you support others facing hardships?


