



Dear Parishioners.

This Sunday we continue reading from chapter 18 of the Book of Genesis. Last week, we heard how Abraham and Sarah were visited by three mysterious travelers. After sharing a meal, the visitors moved on toward the sinful cities of Sodom and Gomorrah. These visitors have long been interpreted either as a manifestation of the Trinity or as God accompanied by two angels. In today's reading, we find Abraham walking with them, now within sight of the doomed cities.

Just prior to this passage (verses 17–19), we're told that the Lord deliberates whether to reveal His plans to Abraham, ultimately deciding to do so because Abraham has been chosen "to keep the way of the Lord by doing righteousness and justice." What follows is a remarkable and almost humorous negotiation between Abraham and God—what's sometimes called the "50-45-40-30-20-10" conversation. Abraham intercedes boldly, asking whether God would spare the city for the sake of the righteous who might dwell there.

The aim of this story isn't merely to chronicle the fate of two cities; rather, it reveals the heart of God—a judge who is both just and merciful, able to distinguish between the righteous and the wicked.

In the end, only three people are saved: Lot, Abraham's nephew, and Lot's two daughters. Lot's wife, though initially spared, looked back in defiance of the angel's command and was turned into a pillar of salt.

As Christians today, we can see in Abraham's dialogue with God a model for prayer. Abraham approaches God with reverence—but also with boldness and persistence. This parallels the Gospel we hear this Sunday, where the disciples ask Jesus, "Lord, teach us to pray."

When Jesus teaches them, He invites them to call God "Father." The version of the Our Father that we know best comes from Matthew's Gospel, but Luke's shorter version offers us a challenge to deepen our understanding of prayer. Jesus encourages us:

"Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." It sounds simple—but what about when we ask and don't receive? When we knock and the door seems closed?

Is it because we didn't ask boldly enough? Or because God isn't listening? Or doesn't care? These questions are painful, and they can shake our confidence in prayer.

But maybe, like Abraham, the real fruit of prayer isn't getting God to do what we want—but drawing nearer to God's own heart.

Abraham speaks, God responds. There's a movement—not just in God, but in Abraham. By the end, their wills seem more aligned—even though the city is still destroyed.

Perhaps this is one of the deeper purposes of prayer: not to hand God a list of tasks, but to allow ourselves to be formed by Him—to be shaped into His likeness, and into communion with His will.

To persevere in prayer is to embrace the mystery of God. Think of the well-loved poem "Footprints." In times of sorrow, we may feel abandoned—but later we come to see that God was carrying us all along.

If I understand the purpose of prayer as deepening my union with God, not just solving problems, then my relationship with Him becomes bolder and more trusting. When God seems silent, I am not defeated, because I still desire to love Him more. And in that spirit, I may finally have the courage to pray the most perfect words of all: "Thy will be done"—and mean it.



House Blessing




