Dear Parishioners,

The opening verse of our second reading this Sunday from the Letter to the Hebrews is one of the most beautiful and well-known lines in all of Scripture:

"Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen." (Hebrews 11:1)

At first glance, it may seem abstract. But when we pause and reflect, we realize that this is a profound and practical definition. It reminds us that faith is not just blind belief or the memorization of doctrines. True faith is lived. It becomes visible when what we

hope for starts to take shape in our lives—even when we can't yet see how everything will unfold.

Some have called this "spiritual knowledge" or "the knowledge of the heart." You've probably had moments like this: when something happens that assures you—deep in your soul—that you are loved. Someone shows up, stays with you, helps you. In that moment, you *know* you matter. Your heart is touched in a way that no words can fully explain.

Often, it's in times of struggle that we discover the strength of these bonds. Maybe you're broke, or your car won't start, or you need a ride to the doctor. And someone shows up. The real gift isn't the money, the fix, or the ride—it's the love behind it. That's what moves you. That's when faith in that person is born—not because they made a promise, but because they followed through when it counted.

This is why Scripture says, "I know that my Redeemer lives." When you've been loved like that, when you've been rescued, it changes you. You carry that knowledge in your heart, and it gives you courage. No matter what comes, you know: I am not alone.

And that's where our Christian faith takes this even deeper.

Each of us knows what it means to struggle—not just with broken cars, but with broken hearts. We are sinners. We fall short. Sometimes, the guilt or shame we carry can make us feel far from God. We might feel hopeless or unworthy. But then—maybe in prayer, or through Scripture, or in the confessional—we encounter His mercy. And suddenly, what felt impossible becomes possible. We are forgiven. We are healed. We are loved.

That experience—God's mercy reaching into our lives—is where faith grows strongest. Not in abstract concepts, but in the heart's encounter with grace. We find ourselves saying, from deep within: "I know that my Redeemer lives."

This is the heart of our faith: not cold adherence to dogma, but a living relationship with Jesus. He is the One who took the burden of our sins. He is the One who walks with us—even through the Valley of the Shadow of Death. When I reflect on His mercy, my hope for eternal life becomes more than a distant dream. It becomes real—because I know He is real.

When I was desperate, He stayed with me.

When I was lost, He came looking for me.

When I was afraid, He gave me courage.

And so, I believe. I have faith in this Jesus, who is always faithful to me. And I trust that He will lead me to what I hope for.

Join us for A Blessed Morning with the Legion of Mary




Jubilee Year 2025: Pilgrims of Hope




