Dear Parishioners,

We read these words in the Letter to the Hebrews this weekend: "Since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us rid ourselves of every burden and sin that clings to us and persevere in running the race that lies before us while keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus, the leader and perfecter of faith." This great "cloud of witnesses" contains the saints who have gone before us. Many saints can be our inspiration to the life of holiness and service that each of us is called to as a disciple of Jesus Christ. Having been inspired then, we too become saints. That is the call for each of us... to be a saint. When our time on earth

is done, we look forward to the new life to come in the eternal joy of heaven. So, the saints not only motivate us to the mission we have on earth, but remind us of the greater joy to come, the glory of Heaven made possible for us because of what Jesus has done for us.

However, the first reading from the Book of the Prophet Jeremiah reminds us that witnessing to the faith often causes stress and division rather than bringing the peace one might hope for. Jeremiah was warning the Kingdom of Judah and the City of Jerusalem of impending doom; the Babylonian Empire would soon attack and topple the city and destroy the Temple. The people don't listen though, and in fact, as we hear today, want Jeremiah killed for all the aggravation he is causing them.

We hear Jesus say in the Gospel of Luke "Do you think that I have come to establish peace on the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division." In Luke 2:34 we heard Simeon prophesy that Jesus will be a "sign that will be contradicted", and Jesus is making clear that the Gospel will encounter the same kind of resistance that the Prophets encountered in their day. The Navarre Commentary on the Gospel of Luke has this... "God has come into the world with a message of peace (cf. Lk 2:14) and reconciliation (cf. Rom 5:11). By resisting, through sin, the redeeming work of Christ, we become his opponents. Injustice and error lead to division and war. "Insofar as men are sinners, the threat of war hangs over them and will so continue until the coming of Christ; but insofar as they can vanquish sin by coming together in charity, violence itself will be vanquished" (Vatican II, Gaudium et spes, 78).

Jesus is the Prince of Peace and came to establish the Kingdom of God in our midst. To accomplish this Jesus came into the world filled with sin (Romans 5:8 "But God proves his love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us.") Sin and the Life of Grace that Jesus calls us to are diametrically opposed to one another. The fact the Jesus is calling us out of sin and into grace will cause conflict. Remember that spiritual adage "Where there is sin there is division, where there is division there is sin." St. Paul wrote to the Galatians: "Now the works of the flesh are plain: fornication, impurity, licentiousness, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, anger, selfishness, dissension, party spirit, envy, drunkenness, carousing, and the like. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things **shall not inherit the kingdom of God**" (Gal. 5:19-21).

Sin always has and always will divide us. The Life of Grace on the other hand brings us into closer union with God and with each other. The ones who have gone before us, the Saints in Heaven, form a great "Cloud of Witnesses" that can be a source of inspiration as we struggle to live the Life of Grace. But as the Church Militant we are the ones who are called today to live in this world in union with God and free from sin. Our lives will at times be a source of division for we are called to be in the world and not of the world; the Letter to the Hebrews encourages us in this way: "Consider how he endured such opposition from sinners, in order that you may not grow weary and lose heart. In your struggle against sin, you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding blood." (Heb 12:3-4)



Fr. Chris presents a Series on the Sacraments



Each week, we'll explore one of the Church's seven sacraments—what it is, where it comes from in Scripture, and how it brings God's grace into our lives. Whether you're Catholic, curious, or coming back to the faith—this series is for you! We will start with the sacrament of the anointing of a sick, by far the most requested of the seven!

The Healing Touch of Christ: Anointing of the Sick

The Anointing of the Sick is one of the most misunderstood yet beautiful sacraments of the Church. It is not "last rites" in the sense of something only for the dying—it's a powerful gift of healing, strength, forgiveness, and peace for anyone facing serious illness or the burdens of aging...

What Is the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick?

The Anointing of the Sick is one of the seven sacraments of the Church. It is a powerful channel of grace, healing, peace, and spiritual strength given by Christ to those who are seriously ill, elderly, or facing major surgery.

This sacrament is not just for those at the point of death. It can be received more than once—whenever someone experiences serious illness or a significant decline in health. Jesus Himself instituted this sacrament. As Scripture says: "Is anyone among you sick? He should summon the presbyters of the Church, and they should pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord..." (James 5:14–15)

During the sacrament, the priest anoints the sick person with the Oil of the Sick, making the sign of the cross on the forehead and the palms of the hands, if possible. If the person receiving the sacrament is a priest, however, the anointing is done on the back of the hands—because a priest's palms were already anointed at his ordination to signify his consecration for sacred ministry.

Through the priest's anointing with blessed oil and prayers, the **sick person receives**:

- The grace of the Holy Spirit to endure suffering
- Forgiveness of sins (if unable to go to Confession)
- Possible physical healing, if it is God's will
- Union with Christ's own suffering
- Preparation for eternal life, if death is near

What is the Apostolic Pardon? When a Catholic is near death, the Church offers not only the Anointing of the Sick, but also a special blessing called the Apostolic Pardon (or Apostolic Blessing). This is a beautiful and powerful gift of the Church, granted by the authority of the Pope, to remove all temporal punishment due to sin—in other words, it remits all purgatory.

It is not a sacrament, but a plenary indulgence given at the hour of death, often in these words: "Through the holy mysteries of our redemption, may almighty God release you from all punishments in this life and in the life to come. May He open to you the gates of paradise and welcome you to everlasting joy."

The Apostolic Pardon is normally given after Confession (if possible), Holy Communion, and Anointing, but it can be granted even if the person cannot speak or respond, provided they were properly disposed in life.

Don't wait until the last minute. If you or a loved one is sick or nearing the end of life, contact a priest as soon as possible. The grace of these sacraments brings deep peace—and prepares the soul to meet Christ face-to-face.

"Blessed are those who die in the Lord." (Rev. 14:13) Jesus, Divine Physician, have mercy on the sick and the dying.

Why is Jesus our hope? Because God never gives up on us. He extends his love and mercy to those who want it, even at the eleventh hour. "At times we have the impression that we cannot find meaning for our lives: we feel useless, inadequate, just like the laborers who wait in the marketplace, waiting for someone to hire them to work."

The parable of the laborers in the vineyard (Matthew 20) "is a parable that gives hope, because it tells us that this landowner goes out several times to go and look for those who are waiting to give meaning to their lives ... God wants to give his Kingdom, that is, full, eternal and happy life, to everyone. And this is what Jesus does with us: he does not establish rankings, he gives all of himself to those who open their hearts to him" (Pope Leo 6/4/25 Audience).




