

Dear Parishioners,

## The Story of Our New Crucifix

A Sign of Faith, Hope, and Love in Billerica

Over the past months, our parish family at St. Matthew the Evangelist has witnessed something remarkable take shape before our eyes: the mounting of a new crucifix outside St. Theresa Church. Now standing tall as a witness to Christ's love, this project has been both a labor of love and a powerful act of faith.

The crucifix itself has a story. Measuring ten feet in height, and weighing approximately 500 pounds, the cross holds a five-foot corpus of Christ with the familiar INRI plaque above. INRI are the Latin initials for the phrase Pontius Pilate had written when he ordered Him to be crucified. These words "lesus Nazarenus, Rex Iudaeorum" translate to English as; "Jesus of Nazareth, the King of the Jews. Far more than a piece of wood, it is a visible proclamation: This is the house of God, and here Christ is at the center.

Bringing this vision to reality required tremendous effort. Clifford Construction, a Billerica company, under the leadership of parishioner and craftsman Barry Clifford, assisted by **Dan** Sullivan, worked with care and devotion. The foundation had to be poured and set, a job we entrusted to our mason, David Graziano, from Graziano Empire Masonry of North Billerica. A sturdy structure was built to support the weight of the cross to ensure that the crucifix will stand for generations. Getting the wood for the cross is itself a story. Barry searched for the wood he needed at all of the local lumber yards to no avail. He ended up contacting a wood mill way up in northern New Hampshire. When they heard that he was looking for the wood to make a cross, they said that they would craft the wood from a single white oak tree. White oak is a wood that holds up very well in the elements. Even details we cannot see—the steel reinforcements, the bolts, clamps, the hours of measuring, sanding, leveling—were done with precision, because the work was done for Christ.

As Barry shared, this was not just another construction job; it was a spiritual calling. "It's an honor to do this for the parish, for the community, and most of all for the Lord," he explained. Those who labored on the project often paused to reflect, aware that they were preparing a sign that will draw countless hearts to prayer.

The crucifix was made possible through the generosity of parishioners who gave donations, of craftsmen who offered their skill, the staff who labored behind the scenes to advance the project to its completion, and of so many who prayed for its safe installation. It stands now not only as a symbol of Christ's sacrifice, but as a monument to the unity of our parish family—working together for God's glory.

As you walk or drive past St. Theresa, let your heart be lifted up. See in that crucifix both the suffering and the victory of Jesus. Let it remind you of the love that saves us, and of the faith that continues to grow here in Billerica. May this crucifix inspire us to live out our mission: to know Christ and to make Him known.

# THE FIRST MILLENNIAL SAINT CARLO ACUTIS

Canonized September 7, 2025

#### DID YOU KNOW HE WAS A GAMER?

He liked Nintendo Game Boy and GameCube as well as PlayStation and Xbox. He had conversations with his gaming buddies about the importance of going to Mass and confession and limited his video game playing to no more than two hours per week. Carlo also liked Spider-Man and Pokémon.

#### WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT CARLO

- Carlo was born in 1991 in London and moved to Milan, Italy shortly after.
- He was diagnosed with leukemia as a teenager.
- Carlo loved to pray the rosary. After he made his First Communion, he attended Mass as often as possible at the parish across from his elementary school.
- He was a faithful friend. He was known for standing up for kids at school who got bullied, specifically a classmate with special needs. With his friends, he spoke about the importance of going to Mass and confession, and human dignity.
- He used his computer skills and internet know-how to help his family put together a presentation on Eucharistic miracles that has been displayed at thousands of parishes on five continents.
- Carlo died on Oct. 12, 2006, and was buried in Assisi. His body lies in repose in a glass tomb in Assisi where he can be seen in jeans and a pair of Nike sneakers


