
## St. Matthew the Evangelist Parish



"Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross" September 14, 2025

#### Dear Parishioners,

This week we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. The Cross is the sign of our salvation, and its Feast Day is always celebrated on September 14. When it falls on a Sunday, as it does this year, the Feast takes precedence over the regular Sunday liturgy. The readings chosen for this day are powerful:

- From the Book of Numbers, we hear the story of the people bitten by serpents. When they repented, Moses was commanded by the Lord to lift up a bronze serpent, and all who looked upon it were healed.
- From Philippians we hear the great hymn of Christ's humility: "Though He was in the form of God, He did not regard equality with God something to be grasped..."
- And in the Gospel of John we hear the words that have carried the faith across the centuries: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him may not perish but may have eternal life."



Just before that most famous verse, Jesus explains to Nicodemus: "And just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in Him may have eternal life" (Jn 3:14–15). The bronze serpent foreshadowed the true healing power of the Cross. Jesus must be lifted up so that we may live.

The Cross is indeed the sign of our salvation. We trace it upon ourselves at every Mass, at the beginning of every prayer, at Baptism, and even upon the casket of our loved ones at Christian burial. What was once a symbol of defeat and shame has, through Christ, become the sign of victory and eternal life. By His Cross and Resurrection, Jesus has redeemed the world.

This truth is now beautifully proclaimed on the very front of our church. We have installed a new crucifix on the façade of our building—a visible witness to all who pass by that we believe in Jesus Christ and Him crucified. It is a reminder that we are a people who cling to the Cross, knowing that through His suffering and death, Christ has brought us redemption and hope.

So let us rejoice in the Cross, not as a burden, but as our boast and our glory. This weekend, sing with full voice the hymn of triumph: "Lift high the Cross, the love of Christ proclaim, till all the world adore His sacred name!"





#### **Reflection Question of the Week**

Feast of the Exultation of the Cross

Today's feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross is celebrated in Catholic and Orthodox Churches alike, with the *cross being the universal image of our Christian belief*. It is not the cruelty of the Cross that is exalted, but the Love that God manifested for all people by accepting death on the Cross. Our Gospel reminds us that God wants to enter a relationship of love with us, a love that is offered in His Son Jesus, lifted up on the Cross. As we gaze upon the cross today, may it be an invitation to accept the love that is given and remain in His love. We adore you, Lord Jesus Christ, here, and in all your churches throughout the whole world, and we bless you, for by your holy cross you have redeemed the world. (Saint Francis of Assisi)

• Take a moment to reflect good time to meditate on the power of the cross in your own life. When we look at the Cross, we remember Jesus' love and the

hope He gives us.

 Take time to do an Examination of Conscience, which is simply reflecting on where we have fallen short in our love of God and neighbor.




