



Dear Parishioners,

Thank You When I was in the seminary I would be assigned to a different parish or health care facility each year as a field placement where I would learn from the priests assigned something more about the priesthood and parish life. I was blessed in all my assignments which included St. Catherine's in Norwood, St. Elizabeth's Hospital in Brighton, St. Mary's in Dedham and my last assignment at St. Michael's in North Andover. It was

at St. Michael's I would do my first preaching after I was ordained a deacon. I listened and learned from the various styles of the wonderful priests there, Fr. John Delaney, Fr. Jerry Hogan, and Fr. Paul Keyes. Each was an excellent preacher, and I found myself remembering Fr. Keyes today as I looked over the Sunday readings and tried to come up with a theme for this letter. Fr. Keyes would often mention to a couple during a wedding homily that they should "live with thanksgiving hearts."

I asked Fr. Keyes about what he meant, and he said that one of hazards of being close to another person is that we forget to be thankful for them. When we are with someone every day we can end up focusing on the challenges of living with them and the fact that they, in addition to being the people who drive me insane sometimes, are the people that make my life somehow sweeter and fuller. I think the advice for a married couple to have a "Date Night" every so often comes from this way of thinking. We have to take time to appreciate each other, and we need to give thanks for the people in our lives, even though there might be a lot in the day-to-day that we are not so thankful for.

The Gospel story today is the story of the Ten Lepers. There are a lot of lessons we can learn from the story, but clearly one of them is that giving thanksgiving for your blessings is important, and it is important in the eyes of Jesus. It is true that the lepers were not told to come back, but were told to go to show themselves to the priests. This is because the priest is the one who "certified" them as healed and allowed them to return to their families, the Temple, and their community. Perhaps in the excitement of being healed the only thing the nine could think about was getting back to see their families. But the Samaritan makes a choice to go back to find Jesus, to say thank you, and to offer public praise to God for his healing. Because of this his healing is not only physical, but spiritual as well. Because of his 'attitude of gratitude' God is not only able to heal his body, but to bring him closer to God as well.

The Gospel speaks of the fullness of love. When we experience the fullness of love we are not taking the ones we love for granted, but recognizing how much we cherish and value them. We have moments in our lives that help us along the way, like when one of our children graduates from school and we bask in pride, or when we get a call that someone we love is in the hospital, and we have to get there quickly to be by their side. These moments of intensity can put us in touch with that deeper, fuller love that we have for them. And so can 'living with thanksgiving hearts'.

Some advice from this week's readings might be: Take time each day to be thankful for the blessings you have in your life. Express gratitude generously and often to those around you. Live with a thanksgiving heart. And remember to give praise and thanksgiving to Almighty God, from whom all blessings flow. ~ Fr. Chris

Reflection Question of the Week- 28th Sunday in Ordinary Time

were surprised by God's presence and peace. Be like the leper who went back to say thank you, not like the nine who didn't!

Reflect on how we can use the gifts God has given us. He encourages us to be enthusiastic with others in sharing our faith.

- Gratitude strengthens faith because it helps us see God's work in our lives. Take a moment to reflect on your blessing and thank God for them.
- Do you ever take God's blessings for granted?
- What is one thing you can thank God for right now?
