

Dear Parishioners,

The readings this weekend remind us of one of the most vital commands of the Christian life: to pray always. Saint Paul expresses it beautifully in 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18: "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."

Our first reading from Exodus 17 offers a striking image of prayer in the story of Moses. As Israel battles the Amalekites, Moses stands on the hill with his hands raised in the ancient orans posture—arms lifted and open before God. It is the same gesture the priest adopts during the Our Father at Mass, a sign that the prayer is offered on behalf of the whole People of God.

As long as Moses' hands remain raised, Israel prevails. When he grows weary and lowers them, the battle turns. So Aaron and Hur come to his aid: they seat him on a rock and each holds up one of his arms, so that his prayer may continue and the people may persevere to victory. What a powerful image of intercession—of standing before God for others, and of supporting one another when we grow tired.

In the second reading, Saint Paul reminds Timothy that "All Scripture is inspired by God and useful for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness." (2 Timothy 3:16) Sacred Scripture contains the wisdom and guidance we need to navigate this world. As Saint Jerome said, "Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ."


From the commandment "Honor your father and your mother" (Exodus 20:12) to the soaring poetry of 1 Corinthians 13 - "Love is patient and kind... Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never ends."—God reveals that to love is to pray and to pray is to love.

One of the most tender ways we love is through intercessory prayer—lifting up to God those in need, near and far. Many of us grew up with the simple habit of making the Sign of the Cross whenever we heard a siren, praying for whoever was in distress. That same spirit of compassion should move us to pray for our families, friends, parishioners, our Bishop, and our Holy Father.

Take a few moments each day to bring others' needs before the Lord. Someone once said, "We will never know the good our prayers have done until someone thanks us in Heaven for helping them get there."

Today, let us renew our trust in the power of prayer. None of us can persevere alone—and, thanks be to God, we don't have to. Like Moses, we are upheld by others' faith; and in turn, we uphold them. Let us pray always, pray generously, and remember that God always hears our prayers—even the quietest sighs of the heart.


chapter to join. All are welcome!

smile, every volunteer plays an important role in bringing Christ's care and presence to others.


