Classes are offered for children ages 4 to 17, on Sunday mornings from September through May. Instruction is included for children preparing to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, First Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation. Weekly family participation in the celebration of the Mass is required. These classes are formative and children must register in the program every year.

## RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

R.C.I.A. is a program of formation designed for those in our community who wish to celebrate the Sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation in the Catholic Church. All are welcome. Contact the parish office for an explanation of the rite and dates for the program. We look forward to you joining our parish community.

## SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is the beginning of the life of a child in the community of faith. Baptisms are celebrated on Saturday evenings or Sunday mornings in the presence of the community at Mass. Parents are asked to first contact the parish office well in advance of the Baptism date desired to obtain required forms and to preregister with their godparents for a Baptism class.

## SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Engaged couples are asked to contact the parish office to make an appointment to prepare for the ceremony, one year to six months in advance of the ceremony.

Please contact the parish office about anyone who is homebound, hospitalized, in assisted living or in a nursing home, or seriously ill so that the Eucharist may be brought to them and the Sacrament of the Sick may be administered if needed.
