### **Reflection on Sacred Scripture for the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord**

Mary and Joseph bring to the Temple their firstborn who, in accordance with the law, had to be redeemed or “bought back” by means of the prescribed sacrifice. Thirty-three years later, Jesus himself will be the sacrifice that is offered on our behalf, for our redemption. Additionally, Mary’s unique and maternal share in her Son’s redemptive suffering – the sword that will pierce her heart – means that we always have a place in her heart: we can turn to her with our sufferings and our sins. Finally, the candles that are traditionally blessed on this day, also known as Candlemas, remind us that Jesus is the light of the world and the light of our life.

*Feasts & Memorials***Saint Agatha****Memorial, February 5**

Since ancient times, Agatha's virginal martyrdom in Catania, Sicily, has been commemorated on this date. Agatha is one of seven female martyrs who are named after the consecration in the Roman Canon (Eucharistic Prayer 1), along with eight male counterparts. The faithful in Malta and Sicily have always had particular affection for Agatha. Her purity and innocence commended her to young women in the Middle Ages, who frequently invoked her alongside virgins Agnes and Lucy. In his 1994 letter to children, Saint John Paul II offered her as a saintly example for young people.

**Saint Paul Miki and Companions****Memorial, February 6**

The fertile missionary fields of Japan were first cultivated by Saint Francis Xavier in 1549. In 1597, the Japanese authorities, fearing foreign influence, began a campaign of persecution with the execution of Paul Miki and his companions. After 1627, villagers were forced to walk over fumie, pictures of the Madonna and Child. Those who refused were exiled or killed. When repeated persecutions failed to destroy the faith, authorities focused their energies on trying to force mission priests to apostatize. A brutal torture known as "the pit" was invented for this purpose. In 1638, Japan was definitively closed to foreigners. Missionaries were again allowed to enter in 1865.

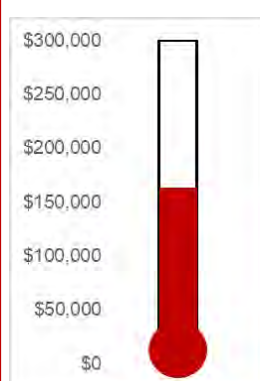

### This Weekend's Second Collection: Catholic Charities California Wildfire Relief

The enormity of the tragedy that has unfolded in Southern California as a result of the wildfires is heartbreaking. The wildfires have killed 28 people with the expectation that number could increase. More than 15,400 structures have been destroyed. 40,000 acres have been impacted. There have been many injuries, homes and businesses destroyed, and entire neighborhoods wiped out. Thousands of brave firefighters and other first responders have been working around the clock to contain and put out the fires. Recognizing the immediate and growing needs, Catholic Charities USA is seeking assistance for relief efforts in response to the wildfires. In the spirit of solidarity, Archbishop Henning is asking pastors to consider a special collection to support Catholic Charities relief efforts. 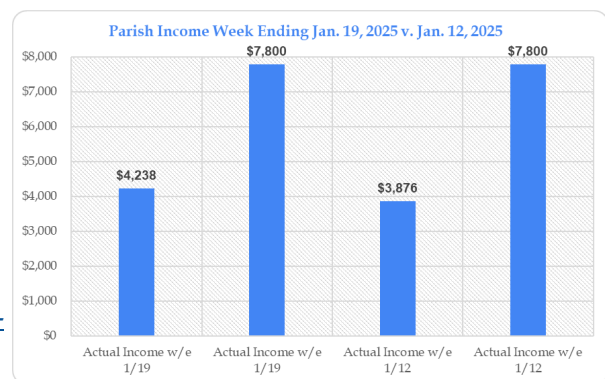

# "HER TREATMENTS ARE LIFE CHANGING"

Finally! A local acupuncturist is helping cancer survivors live lives free from the constant pain and suffering associated with **Peripheral Neuropathy!**

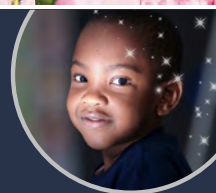
