Application for Memorial and Burial of the Unborn

In Memoriam Inscription

There is a "In Memoriam" monument at each cemetery of the Church of St Maximilian Kolbe – one at Calvary Cemetery (St. Peter's) and one at St. Joseph's Cemetery -- both located in Delano, Minnesota. The purpose of the monuments is to mark "one final resting place" and memorialize those deceased children of God who, named or not named, have not been buried and/or memorialized elsewhere. These children typically include those whose remains are no longer available or which have been buried anonymously.

If you would like to purchase an inscription to be applied to the monument, please complete the section below keeping these points in mind:

1. The inscription should be kept simple and concise with up to 45 characters, including spaces, so that it occupies one line on the stone. Please reflect honor and dignity in your choice of words.
2. Please refrain from expressing sentiments, e.g., loving, beautiful, and instead identify the child by a family name.
3. A date may be included if it is relevant to your loved one's identity.
4. All inscriptions will be subject to review by the cemetery committee.
5. The cost of each inscription is \$125 which includes perpetual care of the surrounding landscape of the memorial wall.

Anonymous Burial

In addition, as a companion to an inscription, an anonymous burial can be requested for a miscarried baby of less than 20 weeks gestation, where no death certificate is required. The cost of the burial is \$50 which includes a sealed casket, labor for interment, and perpetual care of the site.
