



CARE FOR CREATION WEEKLY RECOMMENDATIONS

Georgians will vote again for U.S. Senate to settle the race between incumbent democrat Sen. Raphael Warnock and Republican challenger Herschel Walker. As of today you have two options to make your vote count. You should return your vote by mail ballot to your county elections office in person. Your ballot must be received by 7pm on December 6. On election day, in-person voting will take

place from 7am to 7pm. You must vote at your designated polling station. Don't forget to bring your photo ID with you to the polls to vote. If you do not have an ID with you, you can cast a provisional ballot but will have to bring an ID to your county elections office to cure your ballot by December 9, 2022. You can find your assigned polling location on your voter registration card, by visiting the Secretary of State's voter page (https://mvp.sos.ga.gov/s/) or by contacting your County Board of Registrar's Office (https://elections.sos.ga.gov/Elections/countyregistrars.do)
