

#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

I recently partnered with the Diocese of Cleveland on a new retreat for mothers and teen daughters. The name of the retreat is **BEHOLD**.

As I prepare to speak at this event, I learned that Behold is mentioned over a thousand times in the Bible. When sharing this with my spiritual director, he reminded me that when we hear the word Behold, it is often a special call to pay attention to the words that will come next.

Think of this as an alarm going off to get your attention. This week, we hear John say, "Behold the Lamb of God." Because the disciples were paying attention, they immediately left John and followed Jesus. As Jesus recognizes they are following him, he turns to them and asks what they are looking for. They do not answer the question but ask Jesus where he is staying. Jesus simply tells them, "Come and see."

This is one of my favorite lines in all of scripture. It is so simple but so profound. Come and see!

Today, we can take time to ask what we are looking for. Who are we following? What do we want to see? It is that time of year after the preparations for Advent and the Joy of Christmas that we start to think about what's next. I invite you to take time to truly reflect on what Jesus is calling you to come and see. What are your desires? More money, fame, and influence? Or perhaps you are longing for peace, hope, and joy. What desires is He placing on your heart? Jesus is waiting to hear our response to the question.

As we move forward in our transitions liturgically and as an Avon Catholic community, I invite you to continue to look at the many opportunities to engage and participate. We will continue to partner with the diocese and local parishes to offer opportunities to grow in faith. Consider this a chance to do what Jesus has invited you to: come and see.

Dear Holy Trinity Parish Families,

Last year, Angel Scholarship Fund (ASF) donations amounted to \$130,000 which was used to help reduce the tuition for 92 students at Holy Trinity School (HTS). The ASF allows you to direct a portion of your Ohio state income taxes towards supporting HTS.

It's crucial to highlight that this isn't just a deduction – it's a tax credit. When you donate to this fund, every dollar you give serves as a credit on your taxes up to \$750 per single filer or \$1,500 per married couple filing jointly.

Timing is of the essence with respect to this initiative. While contributions made by April 15, 2024 will apply to the 2023 tax year, only donations made by January 31, 2024 can be used for the upcoming 2024/2025 school year. Donations after January 31, 2024 will apply to the 2025/2026 school year.

It is essential to recognize the significance of the ASF even in light of the existence of Ed Choice funding. While Ed Choice provides substantial assistance, certain families may not qualify for significant support. The ASF serves as a crucial supplemental resource, particularly for those families facing financial constraints in the context of escalating educational costs.

In the past year, we proudly ranked among the top five parishes with the highest amount of donations. With your continued support this will lighten the parish subsidy toward the school and grow the offerings for our parish community. In essence it is a win-win-win. We thank you for your continued support toward Catholic education.


