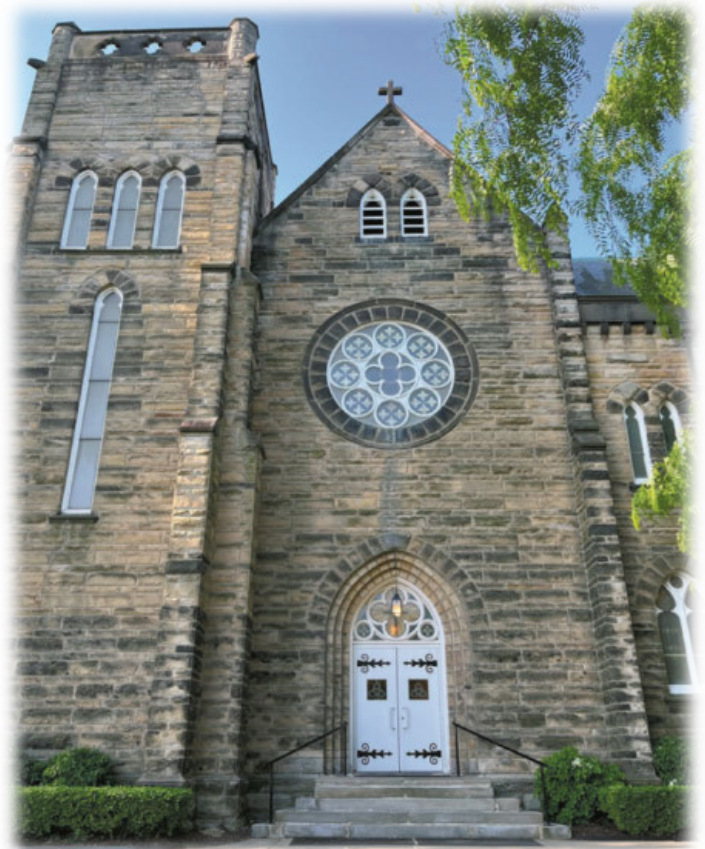

## GOSPEL REFLECTION

I married a fisherman. For years I heard jokes about the “Gould outdoor store,” due to all the fishing tackle my husband owned. I would find myself in conversations about fly fishing, perch fishing, ice fishing, walleye brawls, and the list goes on and on. In this week's Gospel, Jesus calls Simon and Andrew and then James and John, asking them to follow him. These men love fishing; it is their livelihood. They were so engaged in what Jesus said that they dropped their nets, left the boat, and followed him. Suppose my husband (whom I adore) loses an expensive lure while casting; typically, some choice words follow. For a fisherman to drop his net, Jesus had to be wildly impressive. His presence had to be powerful and speak right to their hearts.

This gospel had me thinking back to the homily at our wedding. The priest had the “three keys to a successful marriage” in a tackle box. To no surprise, a tackle box would have to make it into our wedding day – as I stated above; I married a fisherman. We all laughed and then learned what was inside:

- Bible; to keep the word of God in our hearts.
- Rosary; to allow Mother Mary to pour her graces and promises upon us.
- A purple stole; used as a reminder to repent through confession and forgive each other.

Even this week, Jesus says, “repent and believe in the Gospel.” Reflecting on this, I find that we have metaphorically left our boat behind, dropped our nets, and followed Jesus—something we must choose daily. Let us reflect on the question: *What do I need to drop right now or leave behind to follow Jesus? How may I bring others with me into His glory?* After all, Jesus says, “Come follow me.”

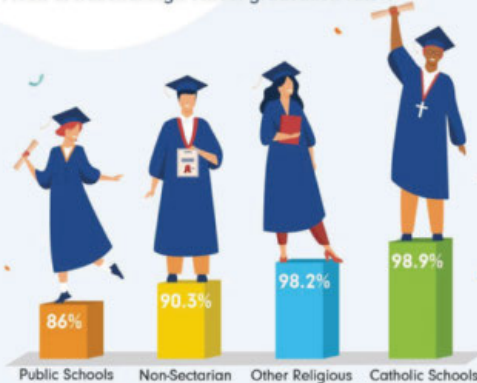
CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK 2024

A look at national high school graduation rates.

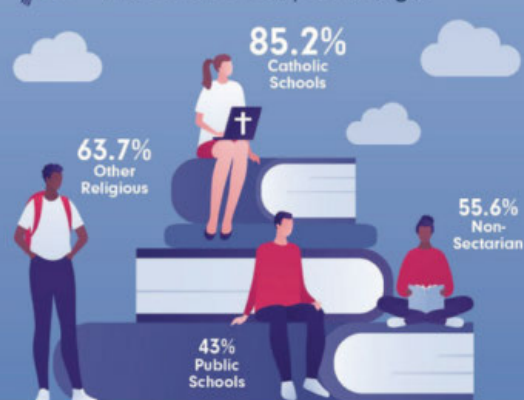


## Number of Schools

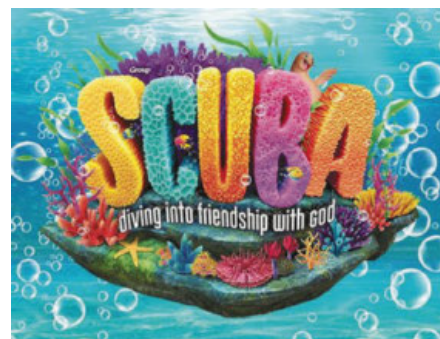
