GOSPEL REFLECTION

As we continue to make our way through January, the Office of Evangelization would like to share the reflection from Luke Brown, at Sacred Heart Counseling. As a community, we have so many ways to recreate and engage in the ministry of our Church. Please know of my prayers for each of you as you look to ways on how you can improve your own "recreation."

In Northeast Ohio, this time of year can be really difficult. No, I am not referencing the Browns. I am talking about the cold and general lack of sunlight. When I moved here from South Dakota, I thought winters would be the same, if not milder and easier. I learned quickly that, while the temperature might have been colder, we at least had the sun in South Dakota. Here in Cleveland, it seems like we can go weeks without seeing the sun sometimes. From what I have observed as a counselor, January and February are generally two of the most difficult months of the year, and self-care becomes even more important. When it comes to self-care, I think it is best to think of it in terms of recreation. The root word of recreation is re-creare, which means to -create. So, with self-care, what are we trying to recreate? Hopefully, we are trying to recreate our energy, motivation, and love of God and neighbor. When we think of it in these terms, it helps us to evaluate what the best forms of self-care are for us. For me, I know there is a very different feeling after watching Netflix for two hours versus watching Netflix for eight hours. If I stop at two, I feel much more rested and ready to tackle the next thing. If I stop after eight, I feel lethargic and lazy. So the question is thiswhat recreates in you what you want to be recreated? When it comes to self-care, we often think first of things like relaxing, treating ourselves, or entertainment. However, difficult things can be very recreational such as cleaning, exercising, or charitable actions for others. It all depends on the person! This week, consider reflecting on self-care and ways that you can potentially improve your recreation during this difficult time of year.



Prison Ministry: Learn about ways you can reach out to those who are imprisoned through writing & visitation.


Feeding the Poor: Assist at various food pantries and distribution centers to support those in need.
