Dear Avon Catholic Community, It has been just over six short months since our parishes have come together in a new way. We as a community have witnessed growth and change throughout both parishes. Certainly there have been a few bumps along the way, but I think overall this new collaboration is working relatively well. As things continue to grow and change, I want to keep you updated on the improvements and updates across our community.

On the campus of Holy Trinity, our Avon Catholic offices have undergon updates. The Rectory had renovations done on the 2nd floor to accommodate additional office space. This building holds the Avon Catholic Administrative offices, which includes both priests, the administrative team and business offices. We have recently hired additional support staff in these areas and need office space to accommodate them. The old convent at Holy Trinity is the Pastoral Ministry Building. The Avon Catholic Pastoral Ministry team includes Desi Gould, our Director of Evangelization, Kevin Kaufhold, our Director of Religious Education, Tammie Frank, our Care and Consolation Minister and a Youth Minister. We are currently seeking a full time Youth Minister and once hired, he/she will have an office in the Pastoral Ministry Building. They, along with a few support team members comprise the staff found in our Pastoral Ministry Building. Our Avon Catholic staff, both new and veteran, look forward to working together to serve both parishes.

On the campus of St. Mary, a lot has been happening. Our new maintenance staff members have worked hard to update the electrical system in the church. This large project is nearing completion and we are grateful for the talent of our team. We have cleaned out and painted a few rooms in the convent and updated some of the light fixtures. This past week, large moving trucks were on the campus and moved our Parish Office out of the Rectory and into the Convent. We are hoping to get boxes unpacked and get the office back up and operational very soon. The movers also took some furniture from the Rectory and moved it into a house on Nagel Road so that Fr. Deo can move out of Lakewood and live closer to us here in Avon. Much of the remaining furniture in the Rectory was moved into storage around campus and will be moved back in once renovations on the Rectory are complete. Both myself and Fr. Deo are looking forward to getting settled into our "new" home - hopefully 4-6 months after renovations start.

Regarding the renovations, I want to let you know where we stand. This past Tuesday we had asbestos testing done on the rectory. Those results are being expedited and we hope to get a firm renovation start date once we have some answers. We have selected North Coast Design as the Contractor for the renovation project. The Diocese is working on the construction contracts and finalizing all of the details. The preliminary renovation quote does not include Asbestos Abatement and a few other low voltage wiring items such as, fire alarms, internet, and phone. Once we receive the final report, I will update you on the anticipated complete cost of the project and how we plan to address it. Thank you for your support, your words of encouragement and mostly your patience as we navigate through the growth and changes to enhance our service to our Avon Catholic Community.

GOSPEL REFLECTION This week, "The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert..."

How are we already in the desert? It feels like we were just gathered together to celebrate the birth of Jesus, and now we are heading into the desert. From feasting to fasting. I have been reflecting on the words "the spirit drove Jesus." What does this mean? I keep asking the spirit to lead me in my Lenten journey. What am I being called to sacrifice or offer, or perhaps what am I being asked to pick up as I journey into the desert?

Like many of you, I have renewed commitments to health and prayer in this new year, which again feels like yesterday. I have also been adding more spiritual reading, something I struggle with in life with a young family, and the demands of ministry. I recently enjoyed reading the work of St. Teresa of Avila, one of the female doctors of the Church. Part of this is because of my work with the diocese in preparing for Behold, a mother-daughter retreat. My presentation at this retreat is about the feminine mind, better described by St. John Paul II, the feminine genius. One of the things I have come to love about what St.

Therese of Avila shares is that she doesn't hesitate to talk about demons, how the devil works, and spiritual warfare. She does a great job of explaining how we can best prepare ourselves. One of her key points is quite simple: stay close to Jesus. We can do this in many ways: daily Mass, regular confession, and time in adoration. Even in our fasting and sacrifices, may they lead us to more profound prayer. It is the spirit driving us, not to a location but to a person - the person of Jesus. Perhaps, this Lent, we should simply allow the spirit to drive us into the the desert with Jesus—side by side. Stay close to him.






