

#### GOSPEL REFLECTION

These past few weeks have been busy, yet we have so much ahead. Within the next month, we will have one hundred forty-six Confirmadi deepening their communion with the Church. In addition, we have 137 first communicants making First Reconciliation this weekend and next. I invite you to continue to pray for all of our young people as they encounter Jesus in these Sacraments. God is good!

As we journey through Lent, I invite you to look at the Stations of the Cross schedule. I am very excited to see the Living Stations hosted by Elyria Catholic on March 22. In addition, there is a soup dinner to begin our fellowship in prayer that evening in the Holy Trinity gym. Be sure to RSVP. I pray we all continue to find ways to embrace this beautiful Lenten season.

Recently, I was in a conversation with Andrew Herbst. He serves the Avon Catholic community in many ways with music and maintenance, and he is preparing to start at Borromeo Seminary in the fall. Please be sure to keep him in your prayers, too. We discussed our favorite liturgical seasons, and I shared how I love Advent and Lent. How we prepare our hearts for Christmas and Easter feels special to me as a mom.

However, Andrew said, I love the Triduum, the time from sundown on Holy Thursday to Easter Sunday. These days are often called the most solemn part of our liturgical year. Lent leads us to Holy Week; these special days ultimately change everything. I am a big fan of the Chosen, and one of my favorite lines in the show is when Mary says, "People Must Know!" This is how I felt when Andrew described the beauty of Lent and the Triduum - three days, but they are his favorite! This stuck with me, and I was reminded of the goodness in those days this week when Jesus says in the Gospel, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up."

Friends, if you are feeling tired or unsure, let me remind you that a lot can happen in just three days! People must know what we are preparing for. Jesus, I trust in you!




