

Avon Catholic Community Holy Week Schedule

Holy Thursday: 7:00 p.m. Mass of the Lord's Supper (location: Holy Trinity)*

Good Friday: 3:00 p.m. The Passion of the Lord (Holy Trinity) -and- 7:00 p.m. (St. Mary) **

Holy Saturday: 11:00 a.m. Easter basket and food blessing (Holy Trinity & St. Mary)

Easter Vigil: 9:00 p.m. Each parish will hold an Easter Vigil Mass at this time.

Easter Sunday: Each parish will follow their traditional Sunday Mass schedule.

*The Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper will have ministries shared between both parishes including lector, Eucharistic ministers, altar servers and choir. All parishioners are welcome to participate in the washing of feet. Those wishing to have their feet washed should bring a towel from home. You will be called forward at the appropriate time for foot washing. Upon reaching the provided chair, parishioners should remove one shoe and sock only. Females are asked to kindly wear pants.

There will be a procession to the gym at the end of Mass where the Blessed Sacrament will remain for a prayer until until 9:50 p.m. At that time we will close with Night Prayer.

**The Divine Mercy Novena will be prayed at 11 a.m. prior to the basket/food blessing at Holy Trinity.

Food Blessings at Easter are an anticipation of the great feast after 40 days of fasting. Foods that will be eaten for the first meal on Easter are brought to church in decorated baskets to be blessed. This custom originated at a time when Easter Vigil Mass was celebrated on the *morning* of Holy Saturday, so many may remember bringing fully prepared meals to church, and going home to eat them on Saturday afternoon. When the Holy Week liturgies were reformed in the 1950s, the Church clarified that Holy Saturday should be a day of great silence, and festivities that had become meaningful to the community should be more subdued or postponed until Easter Sunday. For our food blessings, all are welcome to bring either ingredients or prepared foods in their baskets to carry on the tradition, but as we continue to wait with Jesus in the tomb, the churches will not be decorated, and the new holy water not yet blessed.

GOSPEL REFLECTION

I have a two-year-old, and he has two older siblings who love to mess with him. I love Palm Sunday Mass, but honestly, a part of my motherhood instantly goes to a place of prayer that my children do not hit or annoy anyone around us with their palms. Matt and I are easily in a zone defense in the pew during Palm Sunday Mass. These precious children will certainly drive each other crazy, despite the speech in the car that my husband and I will give about the beauty of Holy Week and the behavior we expect, especially at this Mass (as it may be a bit longer). I apologize in advance to those around us.



It is a beautiful Mass and always prepares me for the gifts of Holy Week, from the energy of the families, the procession, and the engaging and interactive Gospel reading. Palm Sunday has my heart. I ask each of you to take time to look at the liturgies of the week and embrace each opportunity to grow closer to Christ crucified. Leave everything at the foot of the cross. So much happens this week, and our good and loving God forever changes the world.

Beyond our typical preparations and participation in the holiest week of the year, we as a family are also preparing to join others from the Avon Catholic community on our first Mission Trip. Please pray for all of us traveling and those we will serve in the Dominican Republic. We are eager to serve and celebrate the joy of the resurrection in this special way.

I look forward to sharing our experiences and the future mission opportunities available to our community. I can't wait to see you throughout this most Holy Week. Embody the beauty, my friends. "When the centurion who stood facing him saw how he breathed his last, he said, "Truly this man was the Son of God!"
