

#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION** ~ Easter Sunday

One of my favorite St. John Paul II quotes is, "Do not abandon yourselves to despair. We are the Easter people, and hallelujah is our song." Mic Drop. Doesn't it feel so good to be an Easter people? Truly, no matter how your lent went or didn't go, you may rejoice in the Resurrection. It is the beauty of our God that we do not have to do anything to earn His love—we just have it! It is a remarkable feeling to know how deeply loved you are, we are. It is rejoicing in the Resurrection that we also celebrate the gift of each other. Children of God. His love for each of us, as He calls us by name.

I found myself in a conversation this past week with a parishioner about the program Catholics Coming Home (more information on the previous page). This program desires to reconcile relationships with those disconnected from the Church. I invite anyone who feels this separation to look into this program or to stop by the parish office for ways to connect to the life of the church. I invite you to be renewed and embrace the beauty of the Resurrection. Matt often reminds us in our home that the goal is to get each other to Heaven. That is our mantra. How are we working to do that each day? We have many earthly things we might enjoy, such as movies, fishing, ice skating, and football, and the list goes on and on, but the heart of who we are is an "Easter People." Those rejoicing in the resurrection, celebrating not the earthly things but the heavenly rewards.

With steadfast faith and hope, may we celebrate the joy of being an "Easter People."

Sing it loud and proud - Hallelujah is our song!


