~GOSPEL REFLECTION ~ Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

July 14, 2024

We recently went on a family vacation, which happened to be scheduled to start on the same day that VBS ended. It was a busy week; truthfully, as a family, we were wildly unprepared to leave for our road trip to the beach. We had packed nothing. Somehow, by God's grace, we gathered some essential items and hit the road on time. Most importantly, the Gould children made sure they had snacks. As I read the gospel today, I can't help but wonder how the disciples felt. Not only were they asked to journey into unknown territory, speaking with the authority Jesus gave them, but then he told them to pack nothing other than sandals. Not even food. When I shared this with my children, they could not believe that Jesus would not let them bring snacks for the road trip, ha! It is interesting how earthly things can have power over us. The disciples, in their humility, went out two by two; they spoke in the name of Jesus and managed to put pride aside. They focused on their work for God, not for recognition's sake but for pure love and goodness. It is possible to travel light, much like a wanderer, when your focus is not on what this world offers but on what heaven offers. I love these reminders that call us to focus on what we are being called to do rather than what we think we need to do. In youth ministry, I remember hearing, "God does not call the qualified. He qualifies the called." Maybe we can journey ahead, packing light and knowing that we have everything we need based on the authority provided to us as sons and daughters of the King?


