From the Desk of Fr. Hawk



Dear Parishioners,

As we begin the month of October, it is easy to see that change is taking place. The leaves are turning colors and the air cools in the evening. Fall truly is a season of beauty and transformation, both in nature and within our parishes. As you step into St. Mary or Holy Trinity, take a moment to appreciate the vibrant colors and the warmth of community. This season offers a perfect opportunity to explore new avenues, like joining a book study or engaging in a ministry that sparks your interest. Embracing change during this time can lead to personal growth and deeper connections with others. Let the spirit of fall inspire you to discover what awaits in our parishes! The change of seasons is a visible indicator that our lives do not stand still.

It's exciting to see our day school and PSR students returning this fall. New for this year is a revamped structure to the religious education program, building off of the updates made during summer with the debut of a summer PSR program. I sincerely appreciate the work of our director of religious education, Kevin Kaufhold and our most recent hire, Clare Sherman, director of youth and campus ministry. In the brief time Clare has served the Avon Catholic Community, she's launched a new youth group, held well attended bonfires for our middle school students that ultimately kicked off "The Jordan" a new ministry for this age group. I am grateful for the time and concentrated effort that Kevin, Clare and many parish staff members have put into growing the youth ministry program. Their efforts to set the tone and intentionally develop programs that draw youth, teens and young adults to connect to the faith is exactly what the Holy Father asked of us during the Synod process. It is a pleasure to have the Avon Catholic Community help serve as an example in answering this call.

Updates and changes continue throughout fall with the rectory renovation project. When the rectory at St. Mary's is completed, it will have three full suites to accommodate three priests and one guest room. Each suite will include a bathroom, bedroom and small sitting area. The main floor will have a kitchen and community space. These plans are designed to support priests living in community with one another and are similar across many of the rectory renovations found across our diocese. While great progress has been made, unforeseen challenges surfaced making an exact date unknown for when the construction will be completed. The original plaster material was old and during restoration would completely crumble. Extra time had to be taken to address this and make sure the proper material was used when connecting new drywall. Additionally, the plumbing system was completely replaced due to rotted sewer lines and new HVAC systems have been installed with a multi-floor control system for efficiency. Most recently, we learned that the structure of the front porch needs attention during this next phase of construction.

The projected cost of the rectory renovation is estimated at \$770,000. To date, Holy Trinity has contributed \$330,000 to the rectory renovation project. Holy Trinity also funded approximately \$50,000 towards cleaning and providing office space on the Holy Trinity campus for our Avon Catholic Community staff members.

Along with completing the rectory, there are two additional projects that need to be addressed quickly at St. Mary. These are: Eliminating the bat infestation in the attic and basement of church at St. Mary and updating the stairs and handicap ramp leading into the sacristy and side entrance of St. Mary.

Additional Information on the two new St. Mary's projects:

Bat Infestation:

- I am aware that St. Mary attempted to resolve the bat problem before I arrived. The previous vendor has been difficult and because they are from out of state, it is difficult to press them on any further action. We are looking at other vendors to help us eradicate this ongoing problem.
- Bats are a protected species with extermination unable to take place during specific times of the year. A projected start date for extermination is spring of 2025 to comply with protection timetables.

Sacristy Stairs and Ramp:

- The stairs in the area of the sacristy are in major need of repair. Work to repair would coincide with re-working the handicap ramp.
- With the main parking located in the rear of St. Mary's church, I am recommending that the ramp be turned around towards the direction of the parking log vs. its current entry point that faces Stoney Ridge Road.

Diaconate from Deacon Mike

The Church's Ministry of the Liturgy

For all members of the Church the liturgy is "the summit toward which the activity of the Church is directed; at the same time, it is the fount from which all the Church's power flows." Through the deacon's liturgical ministry, the Church sees a reflection of her own diaconal character and is reminded of her mission to serve as Jesus did. During the 2016 Jubilee of Deacons, Pope Francis reminded the Deacons, they serve at the table of the Eucharist, where the presence of Jesus is found. Through the Eucharist Jesus gives himself, the Deacon is to give himself in service to others. During the liturgy, he participates in specific penitential rites.

He may preach the homily. Here the deacon is in a unique position. His other vocations, family and career provide the deacon an opportunity to craft a homily from the perspective of his other vocations. He voices the needs of the people in the Universal Prayer. This aligns with the deacon's call to the ministry of charity. His assistance in receiving the gifts of the people is symbolic with his traditional role in receiving and distributing the resources of the community among those in need. Where he also helps prepare the gifts for sacrifice. He helps the faithful to participate more fully, consciously and actively in the Eucharistic sacrifice through active participation. He is an ordinary minister of Eucharist with a special responsibility for the distribution of the chalice, the blood of Christ. The deacon dismisses the community at the end of the eucharistic Liturgy. Here the deacon is reminded that he is to practice what he teaches. The deacon's liturgical role is beyond the Mass. The deacon can, baptize, witness marriages outside of the Mass, bring viaticum to the sick. Preside over funerals and burials preside over the Liturgies of the Word, communion services in the absence of a priest. Officiate the celebration of the Liturgy of the Hours, exposition and benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Conduct public rites of blessings, prayer services for the sick and administer the Church's sacramentals as designated in the Book of Blessings. The deacon cannot perform the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.

Next time, we'll provide insight into the third pillar of the diaconate, charity.








