As we approach Thanksgiving, please know how grateful I am for our Avon Catholic Community. With each opportunity for fellowship, worship and prayer, I see connections building in the ways our staff, youth and dedicated parishioners contribute to the life of our parishes.

•**Encounter Thanksgiving** on Wednesday, November 27 at Holy Trinity at 7 p.m. This praise and worship festival will feature reflection and music from Fr. Joe Menkhaus and his siblings. This is a family friendly event with adoration.

•**Friendsgiving** for junior high and high school students on Wednesday, November 27. Dinner will be served at 6 p.m. in the gym at Holy Trinity and students may then join Encounter Thanksgiving in the church at 7 p.m.

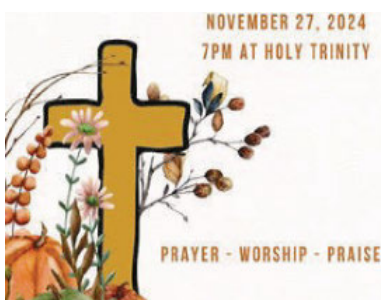
•**Thanksgiving Mass** celebrated on Thursday, November 28 will be at 9 a.m. at St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception.

•**WeGiveCatholic** will take place on Tuesday, December 3. This is northeast Ohio's largest Giving Tuesday campaign that is organized by the Diocese of Cleveland. Each of our parishes has opportunities to support specific, needed improvements. St. Mary's is seeking donations for a new HVAC system, sound proofing and drop ceilings for the cafeteria space. St. Mary's fundraising goal is \$100K. Holy Trinity is seeking donations to restore and rebuild the 100 year old church organ. Holy Trinity's fundraising goal is \$373K. To donate on December 3, visit wegivecatholic.org and search for each parish location. Early donating begins at midnight November 23.

•**Bible in a Year Study** begins January 8, 2025. This study will continue week to week on Wednesday evenings throughout 2025. 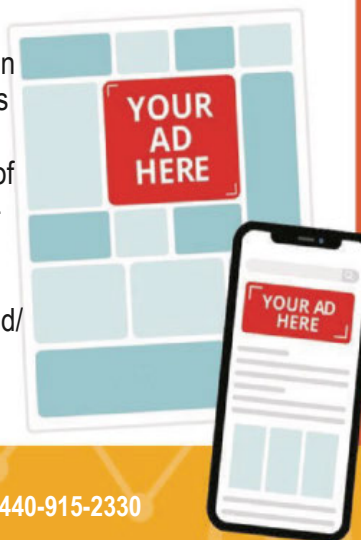
