DISCIPLESHIP DIGEST  
*with desi*

Today we find the disciples fishing in the dark, toiling through the night, and catching nothing. It is only when Jesus appears on the shore — calling out to them, guiding them to cast their nets once more — that the nets become full. In the midst of their discouragement and uncertainty, Jesus is present. He feeds them. He reminds them who they are. He calls Peter again, not just to follow, but to *shepherd* the Church: *"Feed my lambs. Tend my sheep. Feed my sheep."*

This scene feels especially close to our hearts right now.

Last week, while serving on mission, we received the news of Pope Francis' death. There was something deeply moving about hearing it in a space of such humility — among people Pope Francis so often reminded us to see: the poor, the marginalized, the forgotten. In so many ways, the mission of Pope Francis was rooted in this same invitation Jesus gave Peter: to feed, to tend, and to love without counting the cost.

Now, as a global Church, we find ourselves much like those first disciples — uncertain of the next steps, and deeply in need of Jesus to lead us forward.

The conclave — the gathering of cardinals to discern and elect a new pope — will soon take place. It's a sacred process, rooted not in politics or ambition, but in the call to listen for the Holy Spirit. It is a time that demands prayer — prayer not just from the cardinals, but from each of us. The Church needs our prayers right now. Not just for the choice of a new Holy Father, but for a fresh outpouring of the Spirit over the entire Body of Christ.

We are being called to trust. Trust that the same Jesus who met Peter on the shore and fed him with love is still here, standing with us, ready to guide the Church into its next chapter. *Jesus, I trust in you!*

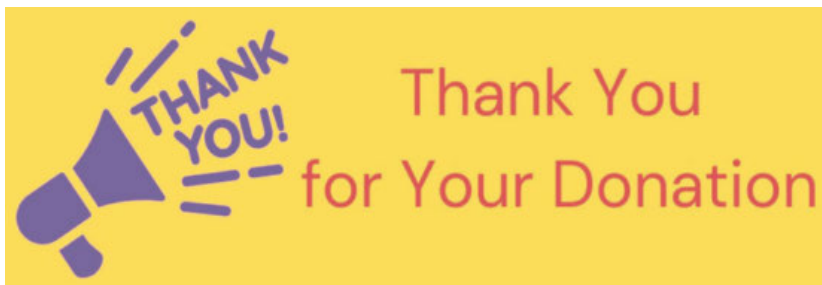

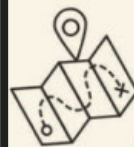
