




CYO Championship Baseball

What is the Pray and Play Passport?

You can scan the QR code (located on the bulletin board at the back of the church) or visit the parish website, which offers ideas to help you pray more deeply and play more joyfully this summer, all while drawing closer to Christ and His Church. Be creative, the ideas are endless! Each entry, aka "air mile," earns you another chance to win the ultimate Urban Air party! How high can your faith take you this summer? Here are just a few ideas to fill your "passport!"

Pray: Attend Mass while on vacation and snap a picture of the church you visit, light a candle and pray for someone who needs encouragement or healing, go to adoration as a family for even 10 minutes, celebrate a saint's feast day with food and fun (bake cookies for St. Martha or have a boat day in honor of St. Peter), or choose a family patron saint for the summer and pray their litany weekly!




