**What is the Sacred Heart, the solemnity we celebrate in honor of this Friday?**



“The Sacred Heart of Jesus is a profound and enduring symbol, representing the immense love and mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ. Devotion to the Sacred Heart is a special form of devotion to Jesus—the focus being his Heart, which exemplifies our Lord’s redemptive suffering for the whole world. The entire month of June is dedicated to His Most Sacred Heart, and this feast day provides Catholics the opportunity to reflect on Jesus’ great love and mercy, and to make reparation for their sins against his Heart.

Between 1673 and 1675, St. Margaret Mary, a nun in the Visitation Convent at Paray-le-Monial, France, received several visions of Jesus, where Christ revealed his Heart as a symbol of his boundless love for humanity and emphasized the need for people to return his love through devotion and prayer.

The exposed Heart, often depicted with a crown of thorns, represents Jesus’ suffering and his immense love for humanity. The flames emanating from the Heart signify the transformative and purifying power of his love, while the cross above the Heart is a reminder of his redemptive sacrifice for the sins of the whole world. The wound in the side of his Heart represents the wound inflicted on him by both the Roman soldier and by all human beings through their sins.” (Catholic Answers)

And yes, demand for this sacred week is so high, we’re already dreaming about expanding our VBS offerings next summer!

Finally, as a community, we have a chance to participate in our VBS service

project: Fill the Truck, Feed the Tundra. We’re collecting non-perishable food items to support the Lorain County Office of Aging food pantry—a real and present tundra where some of our neighbors face scarcity. 


## Avon Catholic Community Vocation Ministry


