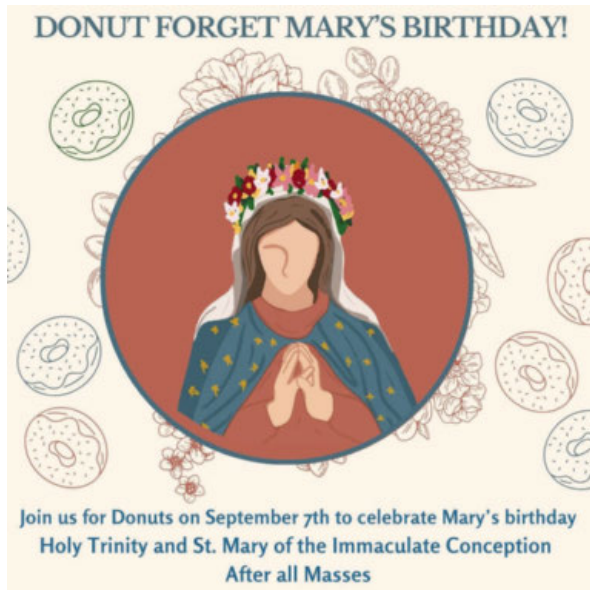
This fall, let’s take our seats at God’s table with open hearts—ready to serve, ready to laugh, and ready to see where He leads us next.

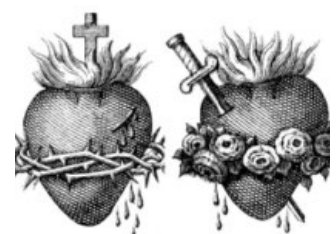

Message from Avon Catholic Community Vocation Ministry

Jesus strives to teach us how to follow Him to enter the gate that leads to eternal life. He is the gate and His arms are open wide. So open your heart to Jesus. And don't forget to give thanks for our parish priests who commit their lives in leading us in our effort to seek the grace to get through the narrow gate.

Catholic Life Explained: Parish Registration

Why's it so important that we register as parishioners?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish, they automatically are parishioners. But membership requires formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of the parish. Census numbers from the parish can determine how many priests are assigned to a parish, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how many Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled. Registration is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you and call on you to assist in its mission. Registering at the parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

Holy Trinity School Theme 2025: Nothing Can Separate Us

Every year, Holy Trinity School chooses a special theme to guide us in prayer, learning, and daily life. In her free time, Ms. Boehm enjoys spending time outdoors, reading, and exploring new places. We are thrilled to welcome her back home to Holy Trinity!

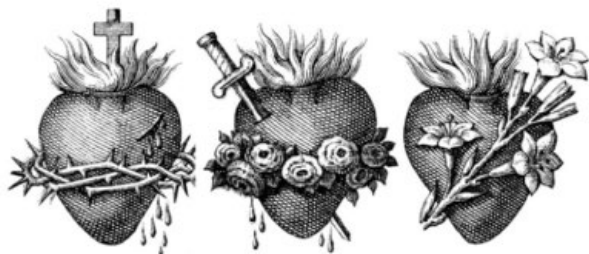
