

DISCIPLESHIP DIGEST with desi

My heart has been heavy! My heart aches for our brothers and sisters at Annunciation Church, and for the reality of the brokenness in our world. I had the privilege of praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet with our junior high students at both St. Mary's and Holy Trinity. These young people are old enough to feel the weight of such tragedy, to carry the sorrow for people they may never meet.

In prayer, my heart kept returning to the Annunciation.

In that sacred moment, God the Father sends the Holy Spirit to declare the Good News of His son to Mary. In this mystery, the Trinity and Mary are present together in perfect unity. How fitting that in our own community, we bear these names—Holy Trinity and St. Mary's—as a daily reminder that we, too, are called to live in unity with God and one another. The Annunciation is not simply a happy announcement—it is the moment when God enters into the brokenness of the world to bring hope and salvation. God's answer to suffering is always to draw near, to dwell with His people.

Our day school students have been working on a prayer chain—each student offering a small sacrifice or prayer, linking them together in love and intercession. Soon, we will send this chain to Annunciation, as a tangible sign that they are not alone. The Gospel this week reminds us that discipleship comes with a cost—that following Jesus means carrying our crosses with Him. It is not easy. But the beauty of the Gospel is that we do not carry these crosses alone. God's Spirit is with us, even in the heaviest moments, whispering hope and strengthening us to remain faithful.

May our prayers, our sacrifices, and our united hearts be a living yes to God's call, just as Mary said yes at the Annunciation. And may our brothers and sisters at Annunciation know they are held close in that same love—by our community, and most certainly by the love of God.

When the weight of the world feels heavy, draw near to Him. Keep praying.






Teaching Children's Catechism

Catholic Life Explained: Parish Registration

Why's it so important that we register as parishioners?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish, they automatically are parishioners. But membership requires formally enrolling yourself in a parish.

Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of the parish. Census numbers from the parish can determine how many priests are assigned to a parish, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how many Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled.

Registration is also neccessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you and call on you to assist in its mission.

Registering at the parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.




