Biffy Vamospercsi's Testimony to Falling in Love with the Catholic Faith and Attending OCIA

Biffy Vamospercsi could feel the community that Avon Catholic is when she first started attending Mass at St. Mary with her husband. She grew up United Methodist, but found something here she wanted to be a part of, so she gave the "Order of Christian Initiation of Adults" classes a chance. These classes educate about the Catholic Church, and at the end of the classes, Biffy was confirmed into the Church at the Easter Vigil in 2024! Now a St. Mary parishioner, Biffy lives out her faith with her husband, Stephen, and daughter, Magnolia, as a teacher at Lorain County JVS! She shares some of her story, and her advice to others considering the OCIA process:

Biffy says, "I chose to become Catholic because it was very similiar to my prior faith of being United Methodist, but after meeting my husband who is Catholic, I just really appreciated the unity and community I felt when going to church with him, as well as thinking about the family we were going to have one day and making sure we had a good strong faith base.

"I feel like it gives our family a deeper meaning and stronger roots, seeing Magnolia grow up in the Catholic Church—she was just baptized on Father's Day—it's just so special to us. It's just a whole community feeling of knowing that these people are there to support and help us raise our family, as well.

"My advice would be that even if you're not sure [about OCIA] in the moment, try it. I feel like there are a lot of valuable lessons to learn throughout and even if you're still wavering on the fence, you're there for a reason. Give yourself that little bit of a push to go and see what it's about, and as you learn the teachings of Jesus and how the Catholic Church affirms your faith, then hopefully it leads you to the next steps of wanting to join the Catholic Church. It's never too late to have that shift in your faith. It is something that can be so small as going to a weekly meeting that will open your life and your eternity to something far greater than you could ever expect.

"I feel so blessed that I have the sweetest little family and we are part of such a great faith community. There are so many people I've been able to get to know that I would have never had the opportunity to if I had never stepped through the doors of St. Mary!"

Today we celebrate the Exaltation of the Cross — a feast that reminds us the cross is not simply about pain and suffering; it is a testimony of God's unstoppable love. "For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son..." The victory of the cross means that in our moments of trial, doubt, or change, we are never alone—Christ has already carried the weight and walks with us now.

In my own family, "carrying your cross" sometimes looks like sleepless nights, missing football cleats 10 minutes before practice, or navigating the chaos of back-to-school schedules. But the cross also shows us the beauty of sacrifice, the strength that comes from perseverance, and the joy that follows obedience to God's call.
