Experiencing the Holiday Blues?



SOCIAL JUSTICE & CHARITY



The Tegeder Fund, established in memory of Fr. Mike Tegeder, was established to fund grants to local nonprofits that support our social justice values. During Advent, we are encouraged to help bring the season's promise and hope to others through our acts of charity. Here are a few opportunities to give a little extra time or treasure to help those less fortunate.

- Our Giving Tree Christmas Collection supplies families at the Cornerstone Emergency Shelter with much-needed new winter gear. The tree is in the church foyer, covered in ornament tags. Each tag has an item listed on it. All you need to do is pick a tag and bring it with you next time you're out shopping. Buy the item printed on the tag and drop it off at the church before January 1.
- Gifts to the Dudley Emergency Fund are used to offer financial assistance to parishioners and community members that find themselves in need. This can include an unexpected medical bill or repair, or even a month's rent.
- **Donations to The Tegeder Fund** allow us to partner with non -profit organizations to complete larger projects. So far this year, The Tegeder Fund has granted \$35,000 to ten local nonprofits.
- Lastly, a year-end gift to St. Ed's general fund supports all our ministries, pays our staff, and maintains our beautiful facilities.
