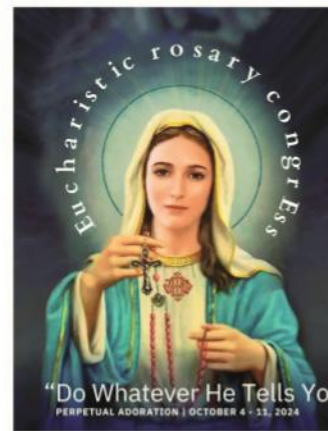

The Diocese of St Augustine is holding the annual Eucharistic Rosary Congress from Oct. 4 through Oct. 11, 2024.

The Rosary Congress parishes host 24-hour Eucharistic Adoration, a rosary at the beginning of each hour, followed by silent prayer, and daily Mass with specific intentions. For the first time, St Paul's parish will be a host parish on Oct. 7th, the Feast of the Holy Rosary. Adoration will begin following the 8am Mass and will continue until 7:00pm in the main church.
