## PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear St. Paul's family, friends, and visitors,

Someone once joked, "I love the Beatitudes... I just wish they were easier to live." And if we're honest, many of us probably feel the same way.

Today's Gospel presents us with the **Beatitudes**, Jesus' powerful invitation to a life that looks very different from what the world often promotes. Rather than strength, success, or recognition, Jesus calls blessed those who are humble, merciful, meek, and hungry for righteousness. These are not qualities the world usually applauds, yet they are the very traits that draw us closer to the heart of God.

Before reflecting further on these readings, I want to take a moment to say **thank you**. Our recent **Feast Day of the Conversion of St. Paul** was truly a beautiful and joy-filled celebration. Thank you to everyone who helped make it so meaningful—our clergy, liturgical ministers, musicians, volunteers, Ladies Guild, Knights of Columbus, and all who worked behind the scenes. Your generosity, time, and love for our parish were clearly visible, and because of you, we celebrated not just a feast day, but the life of our parish community.

St. Paul's conversion reminds us that faith is not static—it is a continual turning of our hearts toward Christ. Paul's encounter with Jesus completely changed the direction of his life, transforming him from a persecutor of the Church into one of its greatest witnesses. His story invites each of us to ask: **Where is God calling me to grow, change, or turn more fully toward Him?**

The Beatitudes echo that same invitation. They call us to ongoing conversion—to soften our hearts, to trust God more deeply, and to live with greater compassion and humility. Conversion does not always come in dramatic moments; more often, it happens quietly in our daily choices to love, forgive, serve, and remain faithful.

As we continue through Ordinary Time, may we carry the spirit of our Feast Day with us—not just as a wonder-

ful memory, but as a renewed commitment to live the Gospel more fully. Like St. Paul, may we allow Christ to transform our hearts so that we may truly be a blessing to others.
