### Lenten Regulations

- ◆ **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are days of abstinence from meat and also days of fast, that is, only one full meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs but they together should not equal another full meal.
- ◆ **The other Fridays** of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
- ◆ **The obligation to abstain** from meat begins at fourteen (14) years of age.
- ◆ **The obligation to fast** begins at eighteen (18) years of age and ends at fifty-nine (59) years of age.
