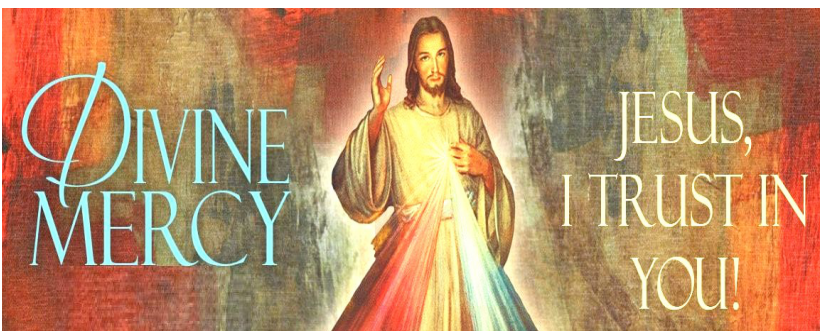

# Statement of the Missouri Catholic Conference on the Abortion Initiative Petition

The Catholic Church supports and defends society's most vulnerable, especially women and children, through accompaniment, social services, and material assistance.

A misleading proposed amendment to the Missouri Constitution suggests that a "right to an abortion" is needed to protect women, while the amendment could actually put women at risk and endanger preborn children. This ballot initiative would legalize abortions in this state and remove long standing health and safety standards for women. In addition, this initiative does nothing to reduce or eliminate the underlying social causes for abortion and does not further a true culture of life in the state.

Groups are currently collecting citizen signatures to add the amendment to the November 2024 ballot. **We encourage all Catholics and people of good will to not sign any petition that would put this amendment on the ballot.**

The Catholic Church in Missouri will continue to provide spiritual and material support to expectant mothers and their families through our parishes and ministries, and to advocate on their behalf and on behalf of their preborn children. For those women suffering from the pain of an abortion, the Church will continue to offer true healing and hope through its Post Abortive Healing Ministries. We ask all to help us in these efforts to safeguard the right to life.

We look forward to the day when every child, born and unborn, has the love and support needed to thrive and reach his or her full potential. Let us pray for a greater recognition of the gift of each and every human life in our society.

## Declaración de la Conferencia Católica de Missouri (MCC) sobre la iniciativa ciudadana en materia de aborto

La Iglesia católica apoya y defiende a las personas más vulnerables de la sociedad, especialmente a las mujeres y a los niños, mediante el acompañamiento y la asistencia tanto espiritual como material.

Una engañosa enmienda a la constitución de Missouri sugiere que el “derecho al aborto” es necesario para proteger a las mujeres, cuando realmente dicha enmienda pondría a las mujeres y a sus hijos no nacidos en riesgo. Tal iniciativa ciudadana legalizaría el aborto en el estado y eliminaría los estándares de seguridad en materia de salud para las mujeres. Además, la iniciativa no hace nada para solucionar las causas sociales de fondo que ocasionan el aborto y no contribuye a construir una verdadera cultura de la vida en Missouri.

Actualmente, hay grupos que ya están recabando firmas para que la iniciativa ciudadana sea sometida a referéndum en las elecciones de noviembre de 2024. **Alentamos a los católicos y a todas las personas de buena voluntad a no firmar ninguna petición que busque llevar esta enmienda a las urnas.**

La Iglesia católica en Missouri seguirá proveyendo apoyo espiritual y material a las futuras madres y a sus familias, a través de las parroquias y ministerios, además de abogar por ellas y por sus hijos no nacidos. Asimismo, para todas aquellas mujeres que sufren a causa del dolor provocado por las heridas emocionales y espirituales del aborto, la Iglesia ofrece verdadera sanación y esperanza por medio de sus ministerios de sanación postaborto. Pedimos a todos que nos sigan ayudando en estos esfuerzos por salvaguardar el derecho a la vida.

Anhelamos que llegue un día en que cada niño, nacido y no nacido, tenga el amor y el respaldo que necesita para disfrutar de una vida plena y alcanzar su máximo potencial. Oremos para que nuestra sociedad sepa reconocer que cada vida humana es un don.
